I do hereby certify that the above map shows any running and corners found on both sides of river from the lower river cor. of Sec. 186 to upper river corner of Sec. 218 on North Concho River - also the Connection between said Cor. 186 and lower river cor. of Sec. 174 on Main Concho River - Also the running and corners found on Main and Middle Concho Rivers to 87<sup>th</sup> cor. 831. - The distance bet from said Cor. 174 to 87<sup>th</sup> cor. 181 is 5264 m. - The area divided between the land there being no intervening corners. - Also the excess between the 87<sup>th</sup> cor. 181 to 87<sup>th</sup> cor. 831 is divided for area between the River runs there being no intervening corners - the distance 8477 being 5375 m. - This Cor. is 1850 m. East and 525 m. S of 87<sup>th</sup> cor. 879 - said Cor. is a Sec. 8. 4677<sup>th</sup> cor. 974 m. - Sec. 11. 644<sup>th</sup> cor. 1144 m. - Both standing - I found old N.W. cor. 24. N.W. cor. 15 & 9<sup>th</sup> cor. 14 conforming to the connection of patented Sec. 29 with the North Concho River runs from which connection I locate the A. & T. Mill & D. Asylum lots, as here indicated. - From the S. E. cor. Sec. 29 & 24<sup>th</sup> Asylum to S. W. cor. 181 is South 4522 m and East 291 m. -
