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Witness trees described at Brooks N.E. Cor. of Hampton Sur. are missing. I placed this cor. at 1125 ft. East from branch called for in Brooks S.H. of Pleasant Sur. and in same line I locate Sec. 1 then ran south and at 180 ft. intersected south line of S.S. Davis Sur. 800 ft. west from its S.E. Cor. and in center of old Charles River this set of logs Sweet Gum Marked 'D' '3' made by Simmons and the pine stake mentioned by Mr. Choice is E. 40 ft. I then ran south with an old and well marked line and at 895 ft. passed 540. East of S.E. Cor. of Hampton as placed by Simmons and marked by me for S.E. Cor. Hampton's survey. I found no evidence of witness trees described by Glasco.
My traverse is shown by red lines and small circles. I found nothing to indicate that the Sabine River has changed its course markedly. The banks are about 30 high and stumps of large trees border on same.

I, D.D. Armstrong, a licensed state surveyor, do hereby certify that this sketch is true and correct and shows the positions of surveys and Sabine River as I found them to be. Original survey on the ground March 23 to 26, 1931.
