Dear Sir:

Inclosed please find a plat of work done by me in hunting the old corners made by Sumnerfield in his original work in the North part of this County

A. C. Knight & R. P. Smyth have done all of their work in these blocks, of the North part of the County, on a Variation which is at present about 12° , and having a great many surveys made on this Var. it naturally causes a great deal of confusion to have this work changed. It seems that Knight and Smyth both knew of these corners but they have never found them or have disregarded them in their work.

I went to work systematically to find the corners and trace out all
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of Summerfield's lines. This line which I have plotted I continued from the North West corner of Sec. 12 Blk S. 4. 4 miles North & 1 mile West to the S.W. cor. of Sec. 18 in Blk S. 1. From which Rock mound on Rock note 320 vrs. N. 15 E. of Mc Kenzie's trail crossing on creek vrs. N. 45 E. 269 vrs." all of these corners of Summerfield's were found on a bar. of 11° at the present time. I run East from the S.E. cor. of Sec 11 in Blk JK 7 miles but could not find the monument there called for in the field notes I searched carefully for several hundred yards around but didn't find the corner, I suppose the corner has been torn down by cattle or has been washed down as the ground there is very sandy

Please examine this plat and field notes at your earliest

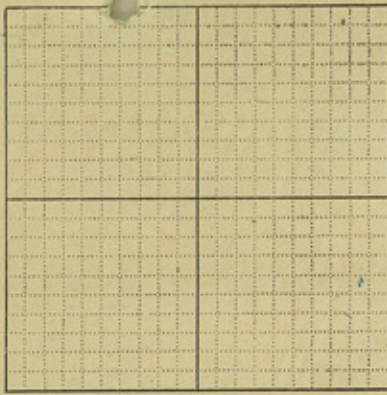
