The low or eastern corner line is 6300 vrs. long West 3820 vrs. to the corner South 5000 vrs. to the corner and place of beginning. For an equal subdivision, I commenced at the N.W. corner and run 2140 vrs. for the corner. Thence S. for the Division line to Buffalo Bayou at below Harrisburg to a Ironwood tree 1500 ft. squares and marked on each side to a pine tree 2 feet in diameter bearing N. 40° W. to a Ironwood 4 inches in diameter bearing West 2 vrs. The league is short by 564.280 vrs. of 25,000,000.

Note: The John Brown league is plotted on this sketch as it was subdivided by Dorius Gregg in 1838 as recorded in Book E p 348 deed records. According to this Survey the Brown was divided into two parts as shown. Gregg meandered the Bayou from SW to SE. Brown and found the marked line as shown, which was the dividing line between the Brown and Thomas leagues. All subsequent subdivisions out of either league were made to conform to Gregg's survey as hereon plotted.

The East 1/2 of the Brown league as divided by Gregg and stopped by marked lines found on the ground, contains 2328.4 Acres while it should have only 2240 Acres leaving an excess of 88.4 acres more than conveyed. If the North line of Brown league was made 4500 vrs it would make the East half of said league contain 2905.2 Ac. an excess of 665.2 Ac. over what deeds call for, besides conflicting two entire subdivisions of the Thomas.
