County of McMullen) I, M. D. O'Sullivan County Surveyor of McMullen County, do hereby certify that the above
Map correctly show the true location of the surveys along the county lines of La Salle and McMullen Counties,
That I made said connections on the ground as follows: I began at the S. E. corner of survey No 157 in
La Salle County made for the C. C. S. D. & R. R. Co. said corner being established by running from the
Established original corner of survey No 132 & 129 made for the R. R. & N. R. Co. said corner being established by running from the
S. E. corner of survey No 157 in La Salle County as fully shown by the red dotted lines on above map, said S. E. corner of survey No 157, being
on the County line as surveyed by Caldwell, Quinn & Brown surveyors of Nueces, Duval and Live Oak Districts in 1877,
it being the County line called for in the field notes of the surveys in said Counties, (said corner being marked
A on Map) I then ran with said County line and East boundary of survey No 157 & 158, North at 530 varas a Post
the N. E. corner of survey No 158 at 537 varas East 21 1/2 varas to a post, the S. E. corner of survey No 1, for the S. B. & C. N. R.
R. R. Co. in McMullen County, I then went back to where I left County line and ran North 547 1/2 varas to point marked
ed F on Map) on County line being 10,863 varas distance between point A & F. Then ran East leaving A line at 212 1/2
varas, found a mound of Rocks the S. E. corner of survey No 43, B. S. & F. at 893 varas passed 25 or South of an Ash Stake which
H placed by Thos. Prandy Co. Surveyor of La Salle Co. as the S. E. corner of survey No 46, at 2112 1/2 varas found a mound of Rocks
the S. E. corner of survey No 48 and the N. W. corner of survey No 3, for the C. C. S. D. & R. R. Co. at 4012 1/2 varas found a post and mound
of Rocks, the N. E. corner of said No. 3, and north of Laredo Road. - I do further certify that I found the distance
by actual measurement from the S. E. corner of survey No 157 (marked A) with County line South 1/2 at 540 varas
found a mound of Rocks on top of Hill south of Green branch at 16,600 varas the Nueces River.
I do further certify that said County line is plainly marked by marked trees and artificial monuments
along the same, and that the red dotted lines on the above map with distances show correct connections
as surveyed upon the ground between established corners, and that the distances are correctly stated on
said map, together with the original corners found upon the ground.
