



I am Armstrong Deputy Surveyor for Brown County hereby certify that I found the upper or N.W. corner of a certain survey for J.W. Glass on the bank of Cedar Bogon at its
 junction with Coleman River from which said Glass had a bearing of S 32° 12' E 328.12 ft. = then turn East 92° 50' 30" following an old madder line to a large stone from which a post oak
 has a bearing of S 49° 45' E also from the S.E. corner of Henry Parkers land on head of cow house 75° 42' 30" to the S.W. corner of James George from
 S.W. corner of section No 32 then South 79° West 700 yards then West 195° 50' and North 34° 12' to the S.E. corner of a survey made by J.H. Diggins which is 24 inches in
 which a line back 24 inches has a bearing of S 47° 15' E then West 280 to the S.E. corner of a survey made by J.H. Wilson which is 24 inches in bearing of S 44° 20' E 122.04
 I found the S.W. corner of a survey made for J. Armstrong thence S 12° 30' E 120 to the S.W. corner of Thomas Wilson = thence East 120 to the corner of the S.W. corner of James Wilson
 thence South 95° 20' E and West 570 yards to the upper corner of a survey made for P.H. Bennett from which said Bennett had a bearing of S 44° 20' E 122.04
 thence South 95° 20' E East 920 to the stone for the S.E. corner of a survey made for P.C. Bennett thence South 20° 30' E Cedar Bogon to the Armstrong Deputy
 I found all other surveys as they are reported on this sketch there is no conflict between my work and any other survey for Brown County
