I. W. Marshall, Surveyor of Mitchell County Texas do hereby Certify that I (accompanied by H. H. Henderson Surveyor) began at the NE Cor. of Sec. No. 28, Block No. 1, H. H. T. C. R. R. Co. which cor. is 3800 Varas North and 800 1/2 East of the North Cor. of the Brookshire Sur. No. 473, which is also the Cor. of Surs. Nos. 34 & 35 Block 2, T & P R. R. Co. From Thence I ran West (crossing streams as represented) 27 miles to the NW Corner of Sur. No. 1, Block No. 1, H. H. T. C. R. R. Co. no corners were found and the line was called for in the center of said Block No. 1, and I believe the same was never surveyed. From the NW Cor. of No. 1 I ran South at 1000 yds. establishing its SW Cor. 2900 yds. E. N. 37 line of survey No. 5 Block No. 15, S. P. R. R. Co. which is N. 81 line I established by going to the recognized old corner of survey No. 1 of said Block 15 identified by bearings and noted Penn and the River crossings. From Thence I ran N. 85° E. at 85 yds. the Colorado River about 75 yds. wide at 1800 yds. a remarkable sharp mountain Peak was due East 3800 yds. in sandy shinnex growth at 5600 yds. cross br. made the Cor. of 34 & 35. Thence N 65° W 1900 yds. in mesquite flat the only place where such bearings as the Cor. of Surs. 478 call for could have been had, though not to be found now, Thence continuing N 65° W with a distance of 500 yds. intercepted line run S. from Sur. No. 1, 2900 yds. E. of its SW Cor. set stakes made 2 corners. Thence N 65° W at 1141 yds. no cor. found for 576. at 3041 yds. no cor. found all the old mesquite trees having been cut down. At 3551 yds. Silvan cor. (C.W.) at 6841 yds. no bearing found but distance to River correct. Thence N 65° E 1900 yds. Thence N 65° W 1400 yds. no cor. at 2100 yds. Colorado River affect N 80° E. 1100 yds. to avoid crossing. Thence N 65° W at 3041 yds. run back to line S 38° W line to Cor. of 203, B. 16 distance to River correct and arrived Hwy. 25. Distance called for from Cor. but not found. This Cor. was previously established by me by running from old established corners on N. 81 line of Block 16, a distance of 1900 yds. from the N Cor. of Surs. 2 & 3 Cor. of Sur. No. 1, the beginning corner of Sur. No. 1 Block 13, H. H. T. C. R. R. Co. There was an excess of 100 yds. on N. 81 line of Sur. No. 1 making it 2000 yds. Thence N 65° W to Cor. of 304, S. W. Cor. of Sur. No. 1, 1811 yds. Thence N 65° W to NW Cor. No. 1, Thence S 150° W to NE Cor. No. 1, Thence N 65 miles NE Cor. of No. 1, H. H. T. C. R. R. Co. Thence N 65° W to SW Cor. of Sur. No. 93 Block 26, T & P R. R. Co. 16 mile Reserve. The Variation of H. H. T. C. R. R. Co. Surs. is 10 E. Time of B. 15, 16, S. P. R. R. Co. & 9300 E. and that of the Reserve is 10° 00' E. I further Certify that the above sketch represents truly the Connecting Lines run together by survey and set for W. H. Henderson land. Witness my official signature this 19th day of August, 1882.

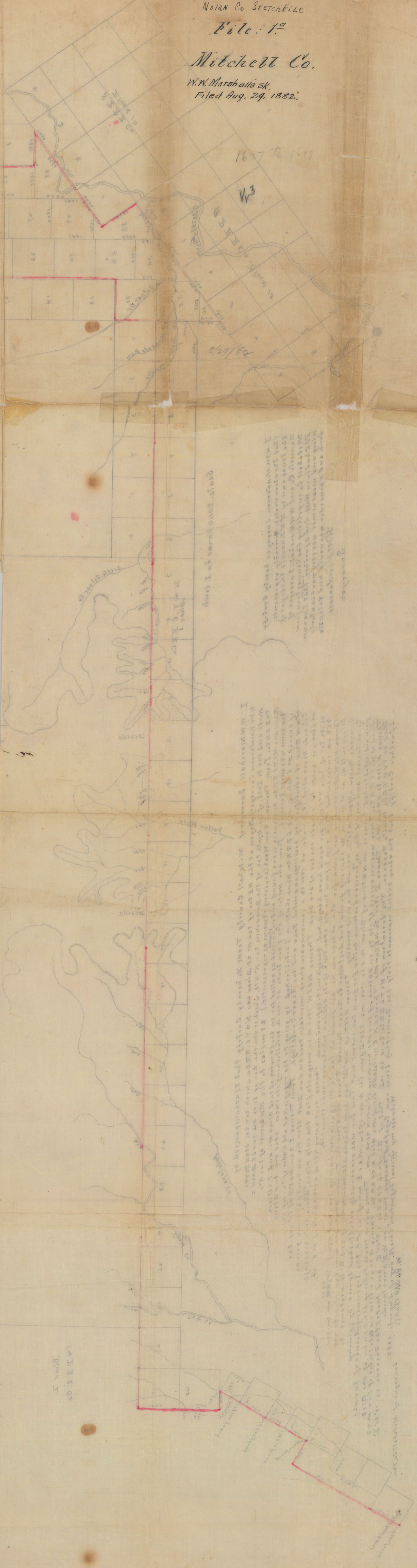

Surveyor of Rutnells Co. and myself, and the remaining 4 courses from N.E. cor. 28 Bl. 1 H.T.C.R.R. Co. to the East Corner of Survey N^o 1 Bl. 15 S.P.R.R. Co. the lines run by W.W. Marshall Co. Surveyor of Mitchell County and myself, and I certify that the same was very carefully run and measured, the variation of Oak Creek surveys is 9° 46' E of Bl. 1 H.T.C.R.R. Co. is 10° E that of Bl. 15 S.P.R.R. Co.
