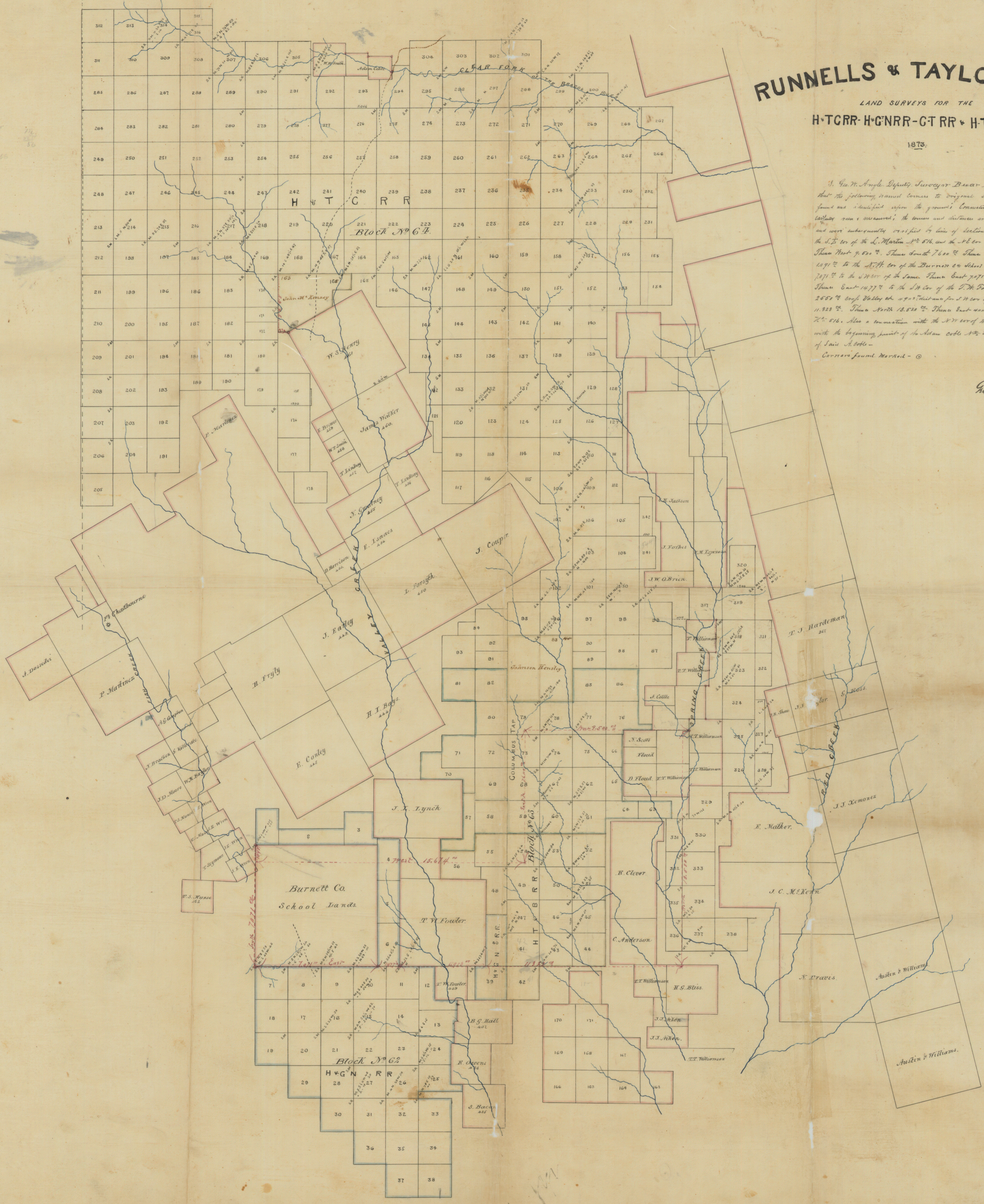

I, Geo. W. Angle, Deputy Surveyor, Beaver District, hereby certify that the following annual corners to original surveys were actually found and identified upon the ground. Connecting lines marked in red ink (including runs & bearings); the courses and distances are correct as stated on this map and were subsequently verified by lines of sections surveyed. Beginning of the S.E. cor. of the L. Martin N° 54, and the N.E. cor. of the M. Sigfusson N° 292. Thence West 4.831⁰ to Thence South 7.620⁰ Thence West 15.674⁰ Thence North 18.912⁰ to the N.W. cor. of the Burnett & Taylor land N° 271. Thence South 7.871⁰ to the S.W. cor. of the same Thence East 7.871⁰ to the S.E. cor. of the same Thence East 14.777⁰ to the N.W. cor. of the T. M. Gardner N° 400. Thence East 26.579⁰ Long Valley sh. 4.990⁰ distance from N.W. cor. of said Fowler Thence East 11.323⁰ Thence North 13.518⁰ Thence East 4.467⁰ to the S.E. cor. of the N. E. sec. N° 516. Also a connection with the N.W. cor. of the Adam Cole N° 366, and back to the N.E. cor. of said A. Cole.

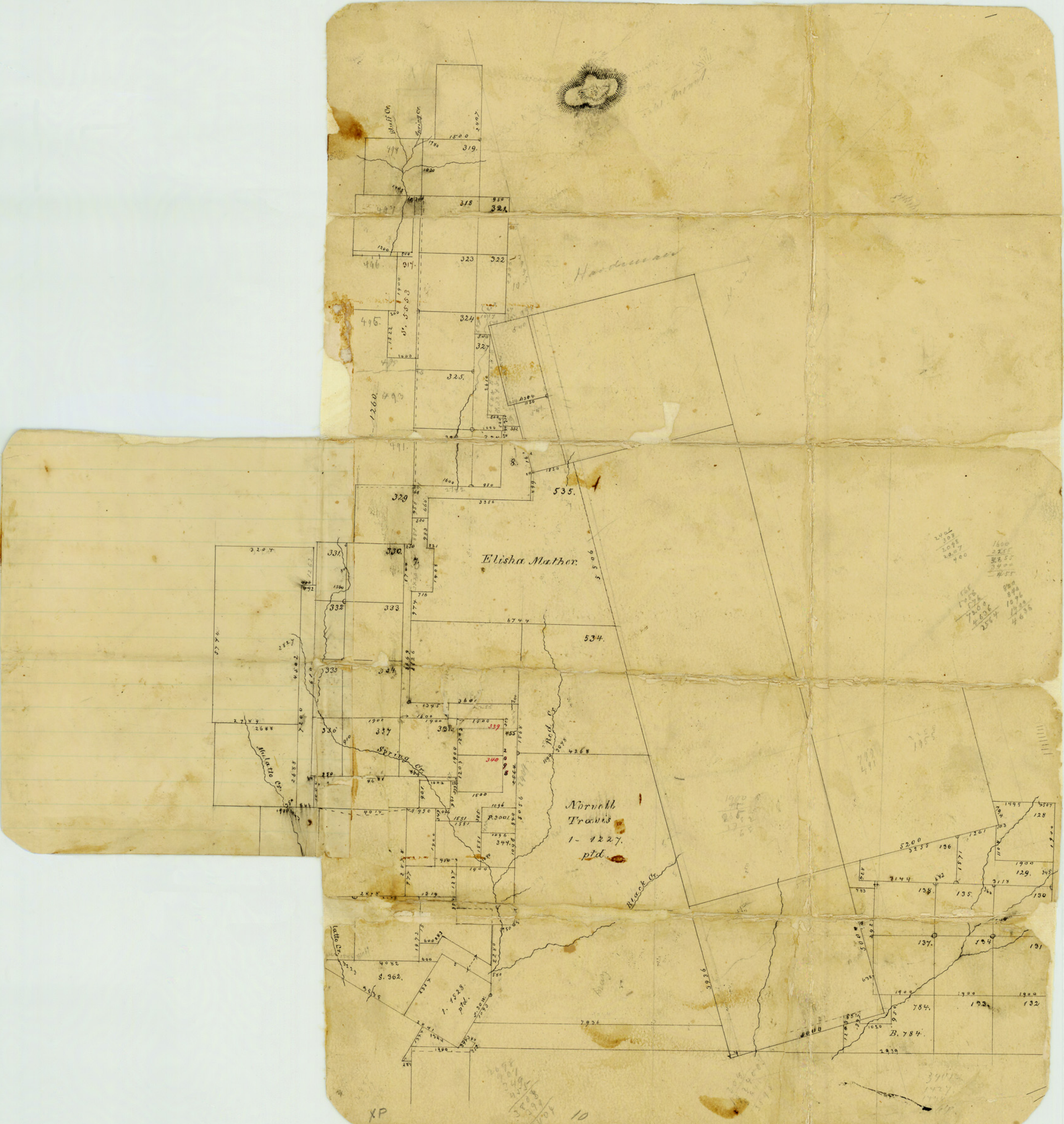
