J. B. Derric County Surveyor of Biscoe County, Texas do hereby certify that I began at the Earth mark a circular trench, and wrought a load of rock made by W. J. Woods a former County Surveyor of Armstrong County, for the N.W. cor of Sur no 1 Blk M. 10., and that I retraced the North line of Blk. M. 10. and found well marked on a variation of $10^{\circ} 54' E$. But also find the East line of Surveys no. 8, 10, 155 and 160, Blk M. 10, to be 800 rods West of Surveys no 61, 63, 65, and 69 Blk M. 13, respectively as shown by the records of Blk M. 13, at Claude, the County site of Armstrong County, Texas and Survey indicated by the red lines was actually measured by me on the ground with the chain carriers duly sworn according to Law. Surveyed for Myrtle Crawford Feb. the 14th 15th and 16th 1906 under chapt 15, page 371. of the acts of the regular Session of the 29th Legislature.
