Dear Mr. Giles;

In locating the John Hamrick survey, I first located the N.E. corner of the Henry Smith survey. There is an old fence line along the course called for in the field notes of the said Smith survey, which begins at a road running along the east line of the Smith survey. This corner was shown me by Mr. A.T. Humes, who states the rock pile called for was at the road side where the fence now corners. I then ran S.60 W. along the fence line which is recognized by old settlers as being the north line of the Henry Smith survey, at 2125 vrs. a corner was shown me by Mr. Humes at a turn in the Gatesville and Clifton, public road which is known as the S.W. corner of the John Hamrick east survey. I then ran N.30 W. along the east side of said Public road 2147 vrs. near an old fence corner from which an old dead L.O. brs. N. 52 W. 26 vrs. also the roots of a L.O. which were found in the ground N.30 E about 15 vrs. At the N.E. corner of the John Hamrick survey the fence is located now a little south of the branch as shown in field notes. There is an old fence along the north line of the survey which was shown me to be the line as recognized. The north line runs along rough broken country.

There is a road along the east line of the Henry Smith survey which runs a part of the distance along the east line of the John Hamrick survey, The Gatesville and Clifton road runs along the west and east line of the Smith and J.S. Savage surveys, to the N.W. corner of the Smith survey and N.E. corner of the Savage survey. Thence the road runs N.60 E. along the north line of the Smith survey to the S.W. corner of the John Hamrick survey; Thence the road runs N.30 W. along the west line of the said John Hamrick east survey.

There is a fence along the north line of the J.S. Savage survey. Also a fence along the west and south lines of the Savage survey, There is a fence along the north line of the J.B. Wood survey and the Gatesville and Clifton runs along the east line of said survey.

At the S.E. corner of the J.S. Savage survey there is a public road and a field on each side of said road. On the working sketch sent me you do not show a L.O. bearing tree called for, at the S.W. corner of the J.S. Savage survey. Bearings called for at S.E. corner not found.

The N.E. corner of the J. B. Wood survey is in Public road and field on each side of said road. Bearing trees called for not found.

The fences and roads along these line as shown on sketch have been a now located for over fifty years according to some of the people now living is this section,
