

Sir,

Your letter of 17th. inst. to hand.
 The land referred to would be described
 as Trl. Secs. 30 & 31 T13 S. R 32 N, and Trl.
 Secs. 25 & 36 T13 S. R 33 N. This land was
 entered direct from the U. S. and was
 not patented to the State.

The act of Admission made Red River
 the boundary line. We hold that the
 bed of the river as it was in 1836
 is the line, which is not altered by
 subsequent changes in the course of
 the river. Our contention therefore
 is, that the above land is still in
 Arkansas although a "cut off" has
 thrown it on the South side
 of the river.
