

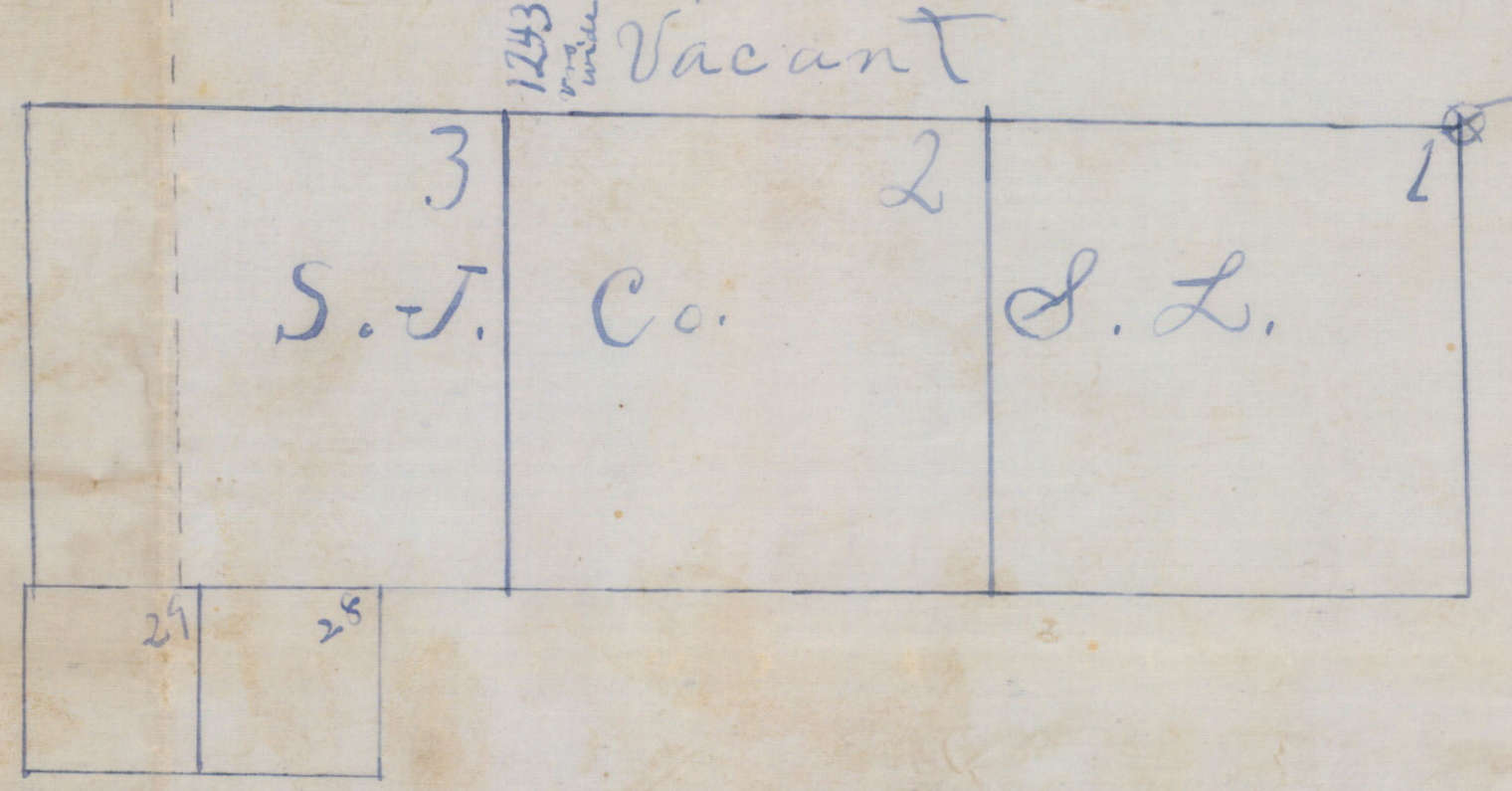
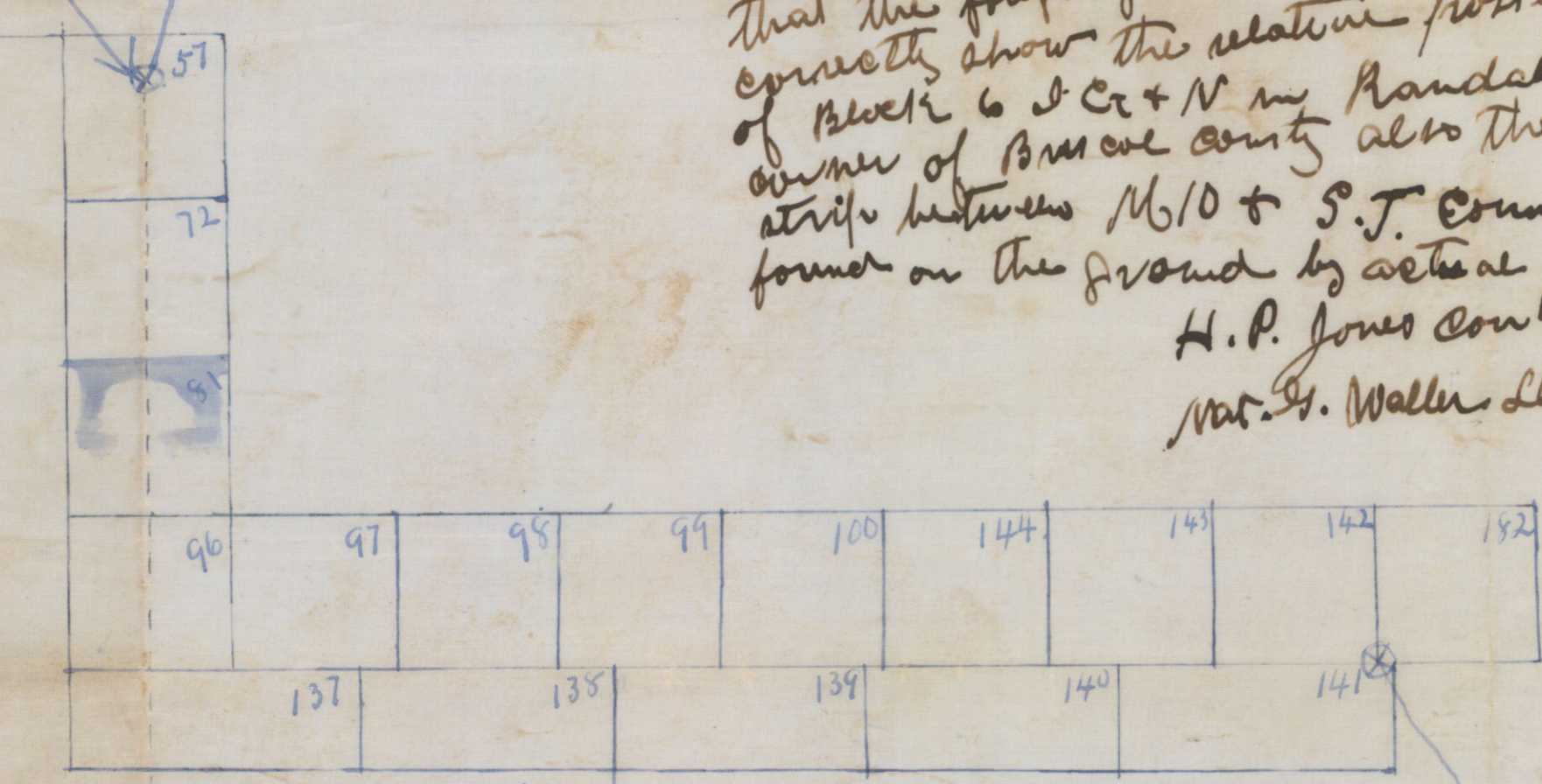

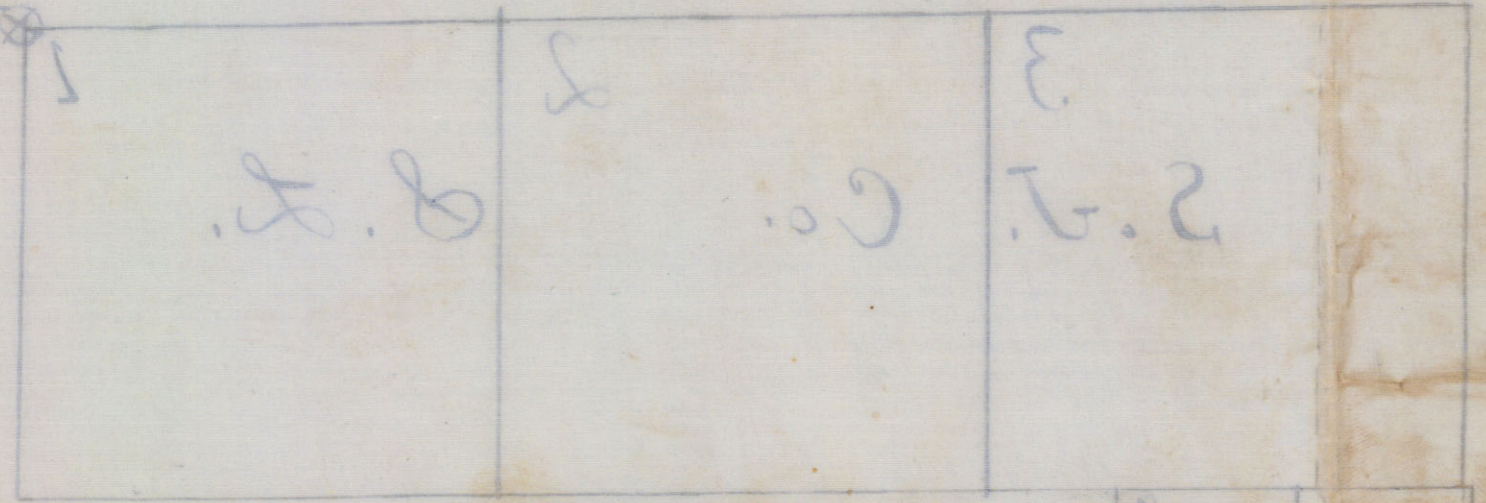

The stone monument claimed by the Swisher Co  
Surveyor as a sufficient reason for the excess on  
survey is a stone that could be carried by a person  
a quarter of a mile easily & there is no evidence  
to establish the fact that it has not been tampered  
with by interested parties.
