Field notes of connecting lines
between different blocks in Biscoe
County Texas

Beginning at the SE corner of survey No 1
B.S.F. Blk B1, ^{at} a plain & well defined &
witnessed monument for said corner.
& running E 5700 varas & 3800 varas N. to SE corner
of survey No 221 D & S E Ry Co Blk C & M. and then
making connection with the SW corner of survey
No 7 D & S E Ry Co Blk G & C 2. which is
also a well defined & witnessed corner.
I find that the said SE corner of survey
No 221 is 556 varas S & 475 varas W from
the SW corner of said survey No 1 D & S E Ry
Co Blk G & C 2.

Taking up the same connecting line
at the SE corner corner of survey No 1
B.S.F. Blk. B1. and running 9 miles N
and 2168 varas E arriving at a point 235
varas due S from the SW corner of survey
No 78 D & F Co which connection I brought
from the SE corner of survey No 39 D & P Ry Co
which corner is in good position as
shown by a survey from the SW cor-
ner of survey No 74 E.I. & R.R. Ry Co.

Beginning at the NW corner of Survey No 5. D & S E Ry Co. Cert. No 206. which is a well defined & witnessed corner and runs to the NE corner of 36. D & P Ry Co which corner was proven from the NE corner of 34 same block. I find said NE corner of 36 to be 2955. varcos S + 4098 varcos W from the NW corner of said Survey No 5. D & S E Ry Co.
