County of Tom Green. This is to certify that S. C. E. Davis, ex-deputy Surveyor of Tom Green County, Texas, on in the latter part of the month of December A.D. 1885 survey as follows: Beginning in said Tom Green County on the north of Cross Neck creek about 15 miles northward from San Angelo, at the N.E. cor. of Section No. 108 and N.W. corner of Section No. 109, Washington Co. R. R. Company, a stone md. from which the three line oak bearing true old markers $\frac{1}{2}$ bear respectively $N 36^{\circ} W 100$, $S 84^{\circ} W 100$ and $S 5^{\circ} W 240$; thence East 116 yards to point; thence North 1973 yards to stone md. at E. cor. of C. A. Ragsdale, fire engine; thence east 8000 old stone md. from which a Cedar 6" diam. old marker $\frac{1}{2}$ bears $N 88^{\circ} W 81$ to the S.E. cor. of Survey No. 20, and S.W. cor. of Survey No. 19, E. L. R. R. Co. thence East 1800 yards stone md. for S.E. cor. said Survey No. 19. Point of Mountain to $N 86^{\circ} W$; thence North 3800 yards old stone md. from which Post Oak, old marker $\frac{1}{2}$ bears $N 12$ to the S.E. cor. of J. Stewart Survey and N.E. cor. of J. Blund Survey; thence West 385 yards, point from which Mesquite, old marker $\frac{1}{2}$ bears $S 61^{\circ} W 50$. Return to last adjacent stone md. the S.E. corner of J. Stewart Survey, thence East 180 yards to point; thence North 4938 yards to old stone md. on point of Mountain from which a Cedar old marker $\frac{1}{2}$ bears $S 75^{\circ} W 20$ to the S.E. cor. of

Survey No. 7, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. (certificate 584) and S.W. of Survey No. 4, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. (certificate 582); thence East 1900 yards point from which a Mesquite old marker $\frac{1}{2}$ to $S 80^{\circ} E 11$ yards and Mt. Hargrove's bears $S 24^{\circ} E 6$. the S.E. cor. of said Survey No. 4, and S.W. of Survey No. 3 (certificate 583) H. E. W. T. Ry. Co.; thence $N 45^{\circ} E 2688$ yards to point east of Juniper Creek, the N.E. cor. said No. 3 H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. the S.E. cor. of Survey No. 2, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. (certificate 581) and S.W. cor. of Survey No. 1 the alternate to said No. 2; thence East 1900 yards old stone md. from which two Mesquite old markers $\frac{1}{2}$ bear respectively $S 54^{\circ} W 28$ to and $S 2^{\circ} W 49$ to the S.E. cor. of said Survey No. 1; thence North at 920 cross branch at 1500 yards stone md. east of Ft. Goodwin and Fort Concho road, the N.E. cor. of said No. 1; thence $N 1500$ yards without crossing either creek or branch; thence West 1900 yards old stone md. east of creek from which two Mesquite old markers $\frac{1}{2}$ bear respectively $N 12^{\circ} E 14$ to and $N 68^{\circ} E 12$ to the S.E. cor. of the A. W. Rowlett Survey and S.W. of this Vandewater Survey; thence $S 45^{\circ} W 2688$ to stone md. the N.W. cor. of Survey No. 2, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. and the N.E. cor. of Survey No. 5, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. (cert 580) — At this point I ascertained that no branch would be crossed in running North one mile, neither in running East one mile, but that I would cross a branch in running West one mile — thence South at 1100 cross branch, at 1450 cross branch at 1900 S.E. cor. said Survey No. 5 and S.W. cor. said Survey No. 2; thence West crossing branch 1500 to stone md. the S.W. cor. of said Survey No. 5, the S.E. cor. of Survey No. 6, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. (cert 583) the N.E. cor. of said No. 7 and N.W. cor. of said No. 4, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co.; thence South 480 yards to Juniper creek; return to the last adjacent stone md. the N.E. cor. said No. 7; thence West 1900 yards stone md. from which Warrens Peak bears $S 9^{\circ} E 6$. the S.W. cor. of said No. 6, the N.W. cor. of said No. 7, the N.E. cor. of Survey No. 8, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. (cert 584) the S.E. of Survey No. 1, G. C. & S. T. Ry. Co. (cert 791); thence North 1900 yards stone md. from which Warrens Peak bears $S 6^{\circ} E 6$. the N.E. cor. of the last said No. 1, G. C. & S. T. Ry. Co. and N.W. cor. of said No. 6, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. — I here ascertained that at a point one mile north of this stone md. Warrens Peak cannot be seen — thence $S 45^{\circ} W 2688$ to a point from which a Mesquite old marker $\frac{1}{2}$ bears $S 72^{\circ} W 16$ to the S.W. cor. of last said No. 1, the S.E. cor. Survey No. 2, G. C. & S. T. Ry. Co. (cert 790) the N.W. cor. Survey No. 8, H. E. W. T. Ry. Co. (cert 580) the N.E. corner of the H. B. Martin Survey; thence West cross creek 1900 to point from which two Mesquite old markers $\frac{1}{2}$ bear respectively $S 79^{\circ} W 12$ to and $N 75^{\circ} W 15$ to and Hipple Peak bears $S 56^{\circ} W$. the N.W. cor. of said H. B. Martin Survey and S.W. cor. of said Survey No. 2, G. C. & S. T. Ry. Co. (cert 791), then I quit work — Errors in my former work were caused by haste, and non-acquaintance with the facts which

I now find upon the ground.
