



Explanation of Sketch

This sketch is made from the Land office a correct idea of the true and apparent conflicts of surveys in that part of Mosley & Floyd Counties where these surveys with their connections east on the Wichita and those with their connections south on White River come together. These blocks surrounded by yellow lines show the surveys showing their connections from Block No 25 H & G N R R Co surveys on White River while those surrounded with red lines show the surveys showing their connections from the N.E. corner of section No 200 A. B. T. M. on middle Wichita at mouth of Jackson Br. This sketch is drawn with reference to White River and Dewey Lake as a stationary point and the surveys having their connections from Dec. 235 A. B. T. M. are shown by black lines in their true position as determined by actual surveys, while the same surveys in red lines show their position as determined by the black lines and the blue northern projection of the E. B. Line of Dec 25 H & G N R R Co survey correct said distance according to the map is 19 miles while in reality the distance as measured on the ground is 23 miles 709 yards being a difference of 589 yards according to survey 12 392 Brooks & Burdson instead of occupying the position indicated by the red lines which shows them in apparent conflict with 1 & 2 M. C. R. R. Co. and 3 by Bealy & Wichita, occupy the position shown by the black lines and in conflict with nothing, so with B. S. & F. No 274 and all that block of land of which Eastland Co. survey No. 4 forms a part.

I, C. W. Williams, Deputy Surveyor Jack Land District do hereby certify that the above sketch is made correctly from the field notes and shows truly & correctly the position of the surveys shown laid down and I further certify that I measured the distance between the N.E. corner of survey No. 2 made for Brooks & Burdson by virtue of certificates No 17 and the E. B. Line of the Susan Salter survey and I find the same to be 10920 yards instead of 2611 yards as shown by the map.
