I, A. D. Wingo Surveyor of El Paso County do Certify that the foregoing map correctly represents the S.B. line of the Pacific Reserve, and that it truly represents the El Paso and San Antonio Road from Eagle Springs to Van Horn Well and that the Red line hereon designated, was run by me upon the ground on the 19th day of Nov. 1880 with a Transit & chain of standard Texas measure, that it is correct, that it is the only road between said points, and that it is the same road, pretended to be designated by Kuechler upon his Map compiled in connection with T & F Ry Co surveys, it is impossible to show the pretended S.B. line of the T & F Reserve according to Jacob Kuechler for the reason that his surveys East of Block No 68 can not be found upon the ground, but from all the authentic data, it is well demonstrated that Mr. Kuechler is in error about four miles in latitude between Eagle Springs & Van Horn Well.
