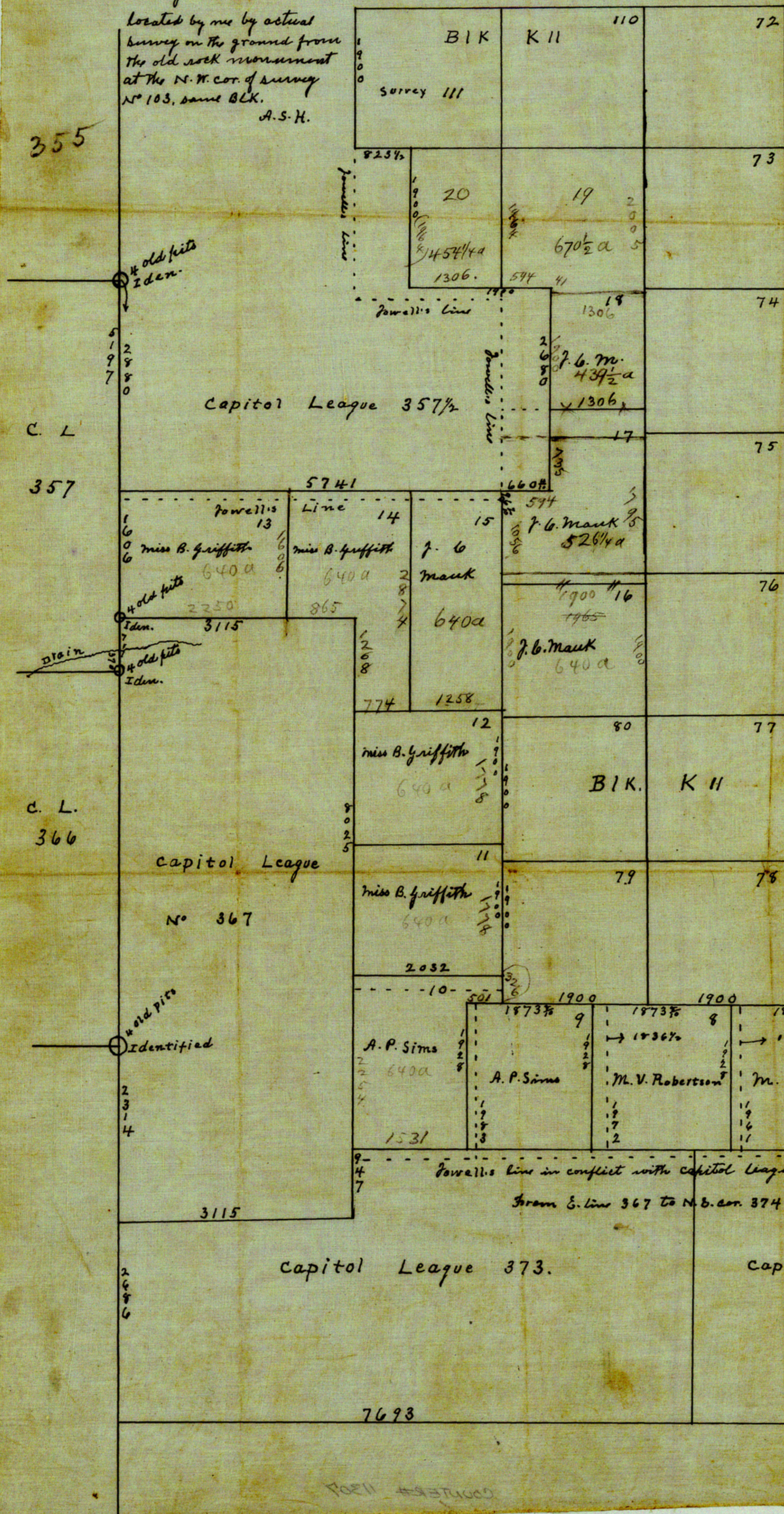


Survey No 111, BLK K 11, was located by me by actual survey on the ground from the old rock monument at the N.W. cor. of survey No 103, same BLK. A.S.H.



This sketch is intended to show the position of surveys one to 18 made by J. R. Powell, Co. Surveyor of Deaf Smith County, with reference to Capitol Leagues Nos 357 1/2 - 367 - 373 and 374, and the conflict of surveys 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 & 10 with leagues 373 & 374 - also surveys 17, 18 (and presumably 20 and 21) with leagues 357 1/2. Dotted lines indicate lines surveyed by Mr. Powell. Mr. J. G. Mauck is the heaviest loser - 313 A. on league 357 1/2 - M. V. Robertson loses lightly out of surveys 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and A. P. Sims out of 9 & 10, provided they can not slide West to include full 640.

The north line of leagues 373 & 374 is parallel with the S. line of BLK. K 11, and the reason between them is 1928' wide - and a 640 acre survey will be 1873 1/2' S.W.
