County of Duval, I. E. J. Foster, a Licensed Land Surveyor, do hereby certify that the above and foregoing map showing Surveys 574-576, and 574-2 is a true and correct map of the area as found by me on the ground, and all original corners and lines are shown which are still standing on the ground. The South corner of 574, no bearing stands, but from the present fence corner standing at its original corner the roots of the Frijolillo called to bear N 8 vrs. were found on the ground and as this corner was identified by Hayes Dix the County Surveyor of Duval in 1906, it has been recognized as such to date. The North corner of 574 still has a large stone standing and its bearing tree cut down. The West corner of 126 and the South West corner of 134, were also found on the ground and the South East of 574, 576, 578 and 580 have an old fence line on the line which has been on the ground since before 1904. I further certify that all corners shown as on this sketch, are the original corners as were found. Given under my hand and seal of office this the 25th day of May, A.D. 1932.
