Dear Sir:

I am sending you enclosed map showing some surveying I did for Mr. Frates in Duval County where I found a vacancy of 18 varas between the north lines of Surveys 38-39 & 368 and the south lines of Surveys 122 and 124. Mr. Wagner tells me that you want me to write telling you just how I actually ran the lines on the ground, which is as follows:

After finding the original bearing trees for the Southwest Corner of B.S.& F. Survey 368, I set a stake from said bearing trees, which was at the corner of a fence. I began at this stake for the Southwest Corner of 368. Thence North with a variation of 9 deg. 50 min. At 951 varas found iron pipe, at 1065 varas found iron pipe, at 1911 varas found original Northwest Corner of 368 from original bearings to be 9.1 varas west of my line.


From original Northwest Corner of 368 I ran west 1037.5 varas and set stake; thence North 1858 varas and set stake and found the ~~NW~~  
<sup>of 124</sup> corner, as established from a mesquite marked "E" (old mark) to be 35 varas East.

I then began at the Northwest Corner of 368 and ran East 927.5 varas and set stake. Thence North 1858 varas, and after establishing the ~~Northwest~~  
<sup>east</sup> Corner of 124 from original bearing tree found it to be 37.6 varas east of 1858 on my line. I then went back to the stake at 927.5 shown above and set post 37.6 varas East of same for the Southeast Corner of the 9.7 acres vacancy and marked bearing trees and took bearings on Loma Alta as shown on map.

I also ran a meander line following cut out lines that I found from the Southeast Corner of 368 to the Northeast Corner of 368 and calculated the course and distance between them as shown on map.
