Dear Sir:

I am sending to you to be filed, corrected field notes of Surveys 362 and 363, Block No. 1, H. & G. N. R. R. Co., Surveys 4-5-12 and 13, Block A, H. T. & B. R. R. Co., on Dickens and Crosby County Line as recently established by Mr. Harris of Lubbock, Texas. Sections 362 and 363 were surveyed by me, a course and distance run from the N.E. corner of Section 329, Block No. 1 known as the Dockum Corner, made by L. C. Wise about the year 1882. The bearing trees were standing in 1907. The Surveys in Block A were put on the ground in my re-survey by placing South Line of Block A two miles Northings from the old Dockum Corner mentioned and for West Line of Block four miles Westings from West Line of Sections 387 and 388, Block No. 1, H. & G. N. R. R. Co. and West Line Burleson County School Land Survey at S. W. Corner of 387 and S. W. Corner of 388 I found and identified Corners made by L. C. Wise in 1882.

I am also sending to you to be filed, the following sections along the line between Garza and Kent Counties as recently established by Harris: 72-57-56-41-39-24-18 and 7, Block No. 2, H. & G. N. R. R. Co., and Sections 12-21-22-35-39-47 and 58, Block No. 7, H. & G. N. R. R. Co., My re-survey of the above 8 sections in Block 2 was in the main a retrace of the work of George Spiller in 1900 and of W. D. Twichell in 1904. At N.W. Corner of 72, Twichell set a stone marked 71-72 at Spiller's old Corner. I added an iron pipe and took Mesquite bearings. At N. W. Corner of 57, Twichell added a set stone marked 57-58-71-72 at George Spiller's Corner to which I added an iron pipe and took Mesquite bearings. At N.W. Corner of 56 and S.W. Corner Twichell set a stone marked 55-56-57-58 at Spiller's Corner, to which I added an iron pipe-whence a Mesquite 5 inches brs. N. 10 1/4 W 9 vs. (Spiller's old bearing). At N.E. Corner of 56 and S.E. Corner of 57, I set a stone mkd. S.E. 57 and iron at Spiller's old Corner. It was a well identified Corner. A. J. McClain, who owned 56, told me he knew this corner was made by Spiller. The North Line of 56 is 1998.8 vs. long instead of 2056 vs. The S. E. Corner of 56 was identified as a Spiller Corner by me. The S. E. Corner of 41 and N. E. Corner of 39 was identified by me as a Spiller Corner. The S. E. Corner of 7 and S. W. Corner of 6, Block 2 was identified by me as a Spiller Corner. This corner is known as the "K Tank Corner". No. 12, Block 7, H. & G. N. has its N. E. Corner 156 vs. S. 88° 51 1/2' W. of Spiller's S. E. Corner 7, Blk. 2. At N. W. Corner of 12 on Block line we have a Twichell Corner. Sections 21 and 22, Block 7, were surveyed by me, course and distance from 11 and 12, giving N side of 12 1900.8 vs. and N. side of 11 1930 vs. In my re-survey of Blk. 2, I divided the distance from Twichell's S. W. Corner of 7 to his S. W. Corner of 9 which is 3860 vs., making S. lines of 8 and 9 1930 vs. Also N. line of 11, Block 7 1930 vs. No. 35, Blk. 7 is 1930 vs. for its N. and S. sides. No. 39 is 1930 vs. on its N. & S. sides and is 634.3 acres in area. No. 39 was pinched up a little in order to leave 47 and 58 intact as re-surveyed on the ground by me in year 1904. When I re-surveyed Block No. 2, T. & N. O. R. R. Co. for Southern Pacific R. R. Land Dep't. and corrected it out of conflict with Block 1, H. & G. N. R. R. Co. The Land Office has my correction of Block 2. In 1904, I put S. Line of Block 7 proper distance (even) miles from K Tank Corner. S.E. Corner, 7, Block 2. Twichell, in establishing South Line, Blk. 2 & N. Line of Blk. 7-in running to the West from S.E. Cor. 7-swung more to the left or South for course (S 88 1/2 W) than I did in running S. lines of 7. This caused the slight pinch up. Section 58, Blk 7, was put on ground by me as re-surveyed in 1904.

I also send field notes of Section 14, Block 4, W. C. R. R. Co., Cert 28/94 in Crosby and Garza Counties. This section was surveyed by me, course and distance from the S. W. and N. W. Corners established by W. D. Twichell in year 1904.

Surveys 73 to 79 inclusive, Block 2, H. & G. N. R. R. Co., Crosby and Garza Counties are on file in Surveyor's Office at Crosbyton and Post. Also surveys 67 to 72 inclusive. I understand they are on file in General Land Office.


