Dear Sir:-

I hand you herewith map and four sets of field notes covering surveys made by me in Goliad County, Texas, for Messrs. Fowler and Fowler of this place. You will see from these field notes that I have made a re-survey of the Seth Cary, Landon Webster and the two B. Breche surveys so as not let them conflict with older surveys.

In making these surveys I first established the eastern boundary of the Manuel de la Pena grant by beginning at its southwest corner on the northern bank of the San Antonio River and 55 varas below the mouth of the Manahuilla Creek; from this point I ran north and found the southeast corner of the C. E. P. I & M. Co. survey, which is on the western boundary of said Pena survey, and from this point I ran east 5000 varas giving the Pena its width and establishing the eastern boundary of same.

Thence North to the northwestern boundary of the Seth Cary survey. I then went to the north corner of the Cary, where I found the original bearing trees and ran same into the eastern boundary of said Pena survey, and the other three surveys were made along the same line.

The surveys in this vicinity are badly mixed up, and I believe I have got these surveys as near correct as possible to make them.
