



Map of the S. J. Rose Smaller Survey and Adjacent Surveys, Situated in Hamilton County, Texas, about 15 miles S. 35W. of Hamilton, Texas, the County Site of Hamilton County

This Map shows the S. J. Rose Smaller Survey and the Caleb Connell Survey as they had been planned by W. T. Saxon, Surveyor of Hamilton County, Texas.

The S. J. Rose Smaller Survey was located by Saxon on April 14, 1881 and the Caleb Connell was located by Saxon August 15, 1881, just four months later. Apparently Saxon was not certain about the position of the Coffman Survey and was not aware of the excess in the Antone Lehmkuhl North line.

He knew where the N.E. Corner of the Antone Lehmkuhl was and is and by running S. 71W. from that point 556 Varas Saxon would have been at the S.E. Corner of the E.G. Coffman Survey had there been No Excess in the Antone Lehmkuhl Survey.

Only 21 years later J.G.W. Pierson, during Saxon's life-time, recognized these two surveys as virtually where they were located by Saxon when he, Pierson, made Corrections of T. & St. L. R. R. Surveys Nos 4 and 5.

I was informed by a previous owner of the Rose Survey that it is now where it has always been and it was he who pointed out the inward corner of the S. J. Rose Smaller Survey to me which is N19W 619 Varas from the N. E. Corner of the Antone Lehmkuhl Survey. This Corner had the appearance of an old corner in 1927. This same owner of the S. J. Rose Survey had J.G.W. Pierson re-survey the S. J. Rose for him. The owner referred to, Mr. J. P. Webb, is now deceased.

I, J. C. Long, licensed State Land Surveyor of Mills County, Texas, do hereby certify that the above Plat shows the S. J. Rose Smaller Survey as nearly reconstructed as is possible according to its original location by W. T. Saxon, County Surveyor of Hamilton County, Texas.
