Gentlemen;-

In compliance with your instructions I have run out on the ground the Thos. Earl Survey and the T.C. Dunn Survey to determine if the said Dunn survey exists in fact.

The results of my survey develop that the Thos. Earl survey actually on the ground and in accordance with the decree in Cause No. 149997 of the 61st. Judicial District Court of Harris County, Texas completely wipes out the T.C. Dunn Survey abstract No. 1393.

The Thomas Earle field notes on the ground and in accordance with said decree are as follows,

Beginning at an iron pipe in fence corner, the north west corner of the Sarah Deal Survey on the south line of the S. Murphy Survey and from which an 8 " Elm Marked X bears West 5.9 vs., and a 20" Ash Marked fore and aft bears South 64 deg. 45' East 36 vrs.

Thence along fence line on the west line of the said Deal Survey South 25 deg. 55' West 2884.1 vs., to an iron pipe the North east corner of the J.A. Harris Survey in a fence corner.

Thence along fence line on the North line of the said Harris survey North 62 deg. 26' West 1548.7 varas to an iron pipe in fence corner on the East line of A. Whitlock Survey No. 92,

Thence along fence line on the East lines of A. Whitlocks Surveys No. 92 and 97 at 74 varas pass iron pipe the south east corner of Whitlock No. 97 and the northeast corner of Whitlock No. 92, and in all North 00 deg. 42' West 1974 varas to an axle and pipe in fence corner the north east corner of Whitlock No. 97.

Thence along fence on the North line of Whitlock No. 97, South 89 deg. 25' West 1149.4 varas to a pipe in fence corner the south east corner of the M.C. Friedenhaus Survey, on the ground.

Thence along fence on the east line of said Friedenhaus survey North 00 deg. 15' ~~East~~ West 1769 vs. to an iron pipe the north East corner of the said Friedenhaus survey on the south line of the S? Murphy survey at a point which is South 64 deg. 08' East 529.02 varas from an iron pipe in fence corner the southwest corner of the said Murphy Survey.

Thence along fence on the south line of the said Murphy Survey South 64 deg. 08' East 4241.2 varas to the place of beginning and containing 1495.1 acres, which includes entirely all of the T.C. Dunn Survey.
