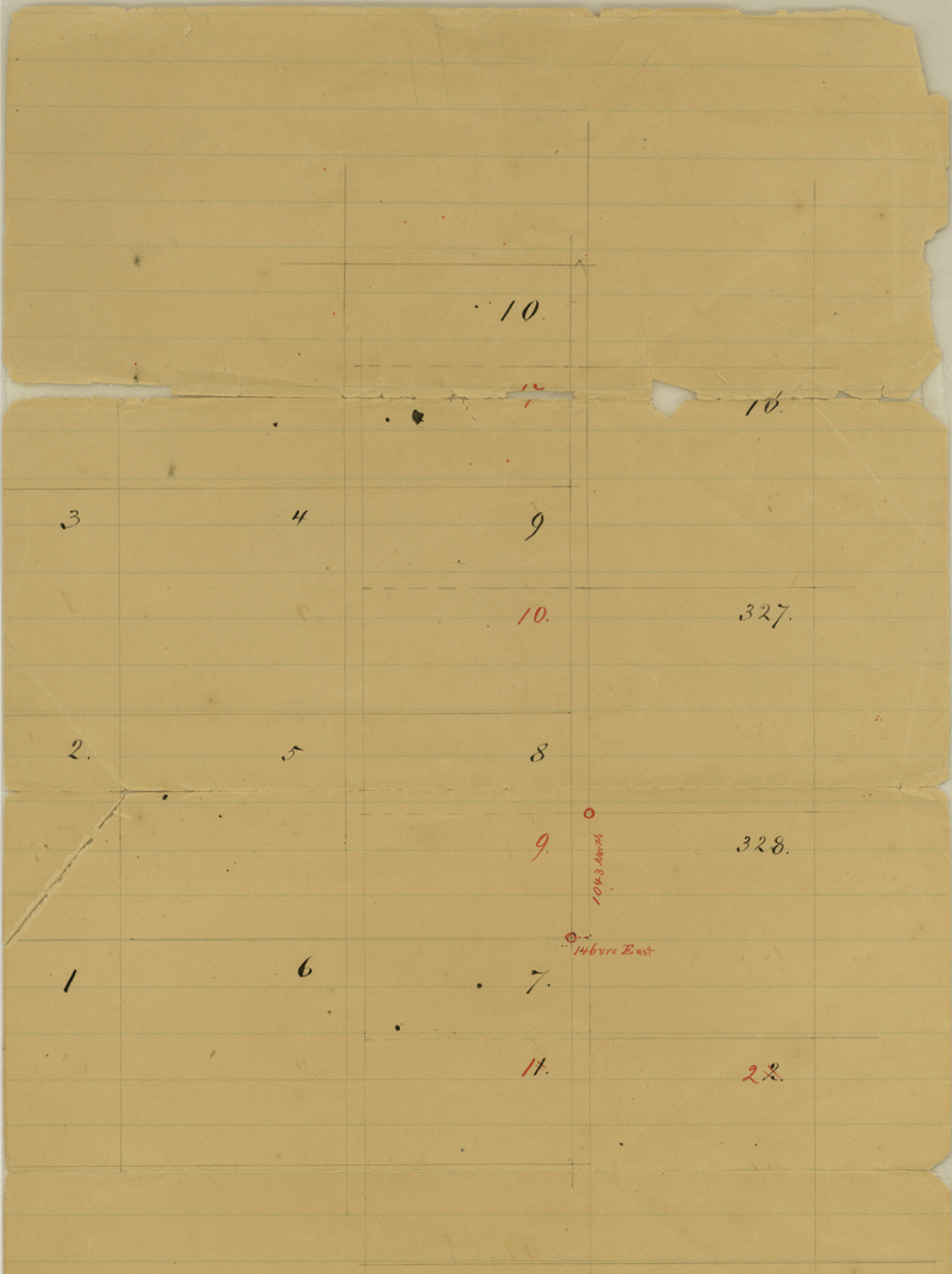

case 118 Alice Bullis et al vs. Galveston
Harrisburg and San Antonio Railway
Company.

Would respectfully report that we
proceeded after giving notice to both
plaintiff and defendant to the South
East corner of the M. Tarrin survey N^o. 33
and the South West corner of survey N^o. 319
from whence an old Indian Villiage on
the bank of a dry arroya brs N80°W480
ors, a high peak topped with solid rock brs
West about 1000 ors.

Thence we ran by the following
courses and distances to wit:

East 1900 ors to rock mound the South
East corner of survey N^o. 319

Thence East 1900 varas to rock mound
the South East corner of survey N^o. 2
Block 8 H & T. C. Ry. Co.

Thence S 52° E 600 varas

Thence N 67 1/4° E 1992 varas

Thence South 9 varas to a rock mound the South East corner of survey N^o 8 Block 8 H & T. C. Ry. Co.

Thence S 77^o E 138 varas to a rock mound the South West corner of survey N^o 327 made by virtue of Land Scrip N^o 407 issued to Adams, Beaty & Moulton and the N. E. corner of survey N^o 9 Block 23 G. H & S. A. Ry. Co. using Variation of 11 1/2^o E making conflict as shown on sketch attached marked "A"

Said survey N^o 9 Block #23 G. H & S. A. Ry. Co. conflicting with said survey N^o 8 Block N^o 8 H & T. C. Ry. Co. nine hundred and forty two (942) varas North and seventeen hundred and sixty two (1762) varas West, being in conflict with N^o 8 in area 294.01 acres.
