Dear Sir: Answering endorsement on F/N Survey No. 2, Blk. M., J.H. Murdock, in Kinney County, Texas, -"Bex-S-50773, 4/1/29, Mc." regarding the identification on the ground of the S. E. No. 2, which is also the N.E. corner of No. 1, beg to say that this stone mound called for was identified by me on the ground on a resurvey of said surveys Nos. 1 & 2.

Mistakenly taking Survey No. 2 for a School section, the excess acreage in section one (1) was placed into Survey No. 2.

The east boundary line of survey No. 2. measures 2688 vrs. between its N.E. & S.E. corners, both identified.

The east and west lines of survey No. 1, measure 2725 vrs. The S.E. corner of section 1 also has been identified on the ground, a large pile of rocks on the south slope of an open hill and the top of mtn N. 36 E. corresponds on the ground to the call.

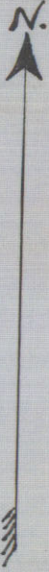
Section No. 26, Blk, M. being a School Section or survey. I have placed the excess acreage in survey No. 1, into survey No. 26. This necessitated the elimination of the original call for the S. E. corner of survey No. 1, since under the corrected field notes for No. 26, the new south line of survey No. 1 will be 37 vrs. north of the original line.

From my interpretation of your letter to Judge John J. Foster of Del Rio, dated April 2nd. setting out the General Land Offices' position and authority with reference to the sale of excess acreage and re-patent of surveys, I concluded that this is the only way that Mr. Hamilton can purchase the excess acreage in Survey No. 1. J. B. Polley.
