

Notes-
From the N. S. cor. of Capital
League 730 to the N. S. cor. of
C. L. 642 the distance is
55,660 ft. or an excess of 660 ft.

From the S.W. cor. of survey 1.
Blk. A. of the Thomson land
to the S.W. cor. of survey 25, Blk
T. there is an excess of 457 ft.

Red circles denote original corners
found by me in 1886, and blue
lines show the lines run at
that time

The buffalo head corner shown
on this sketch near the W. line of
survey 4, Blk B. does not appear
to be a corner of any survey, but
was clearly defined in 1886,
and was 2500 ft. S. from the
S.W. cor. of survey 29, and 5150
N. from creek. No trace of it
now remains. The S.E. cor. of
29 as described by me Chalk
can not be identified, nor
did I see any evidence of it
in 1886 - Six men of my
outfit spent half a day look-
ing for the middle cor. of
Blk B. and failed to find
it - I have since searched
for it diligently

From a careful examination
of the lines and corners of the
Sabine Co. School land, the
Eliza Davis survey and Blk
D10 as they are now fenced
and claimed by the owners,
I conclude that said surveys
have been improperly al-
located - no original corners
being found - the late surveys
allowing for much variation,
and thus making Blk D10
and Sabine Co. School Land
conflict with the Thomson
land which is impossible
if course and distance cor-
rect.
