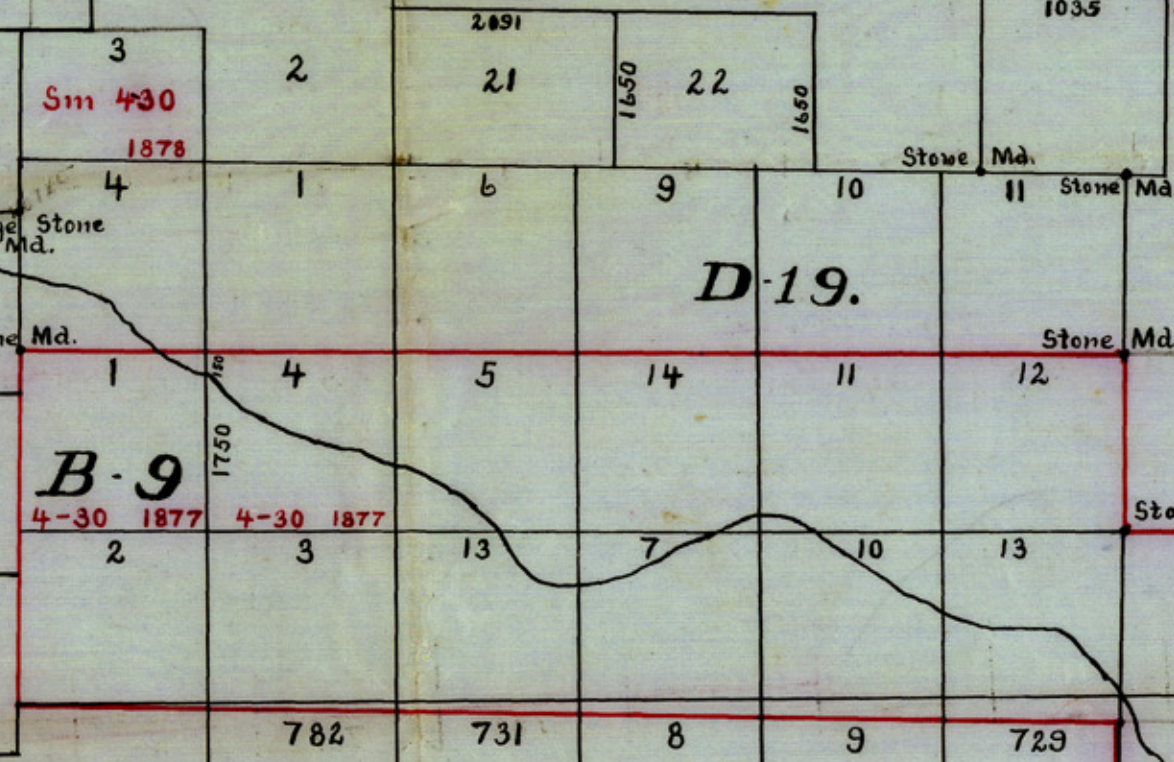
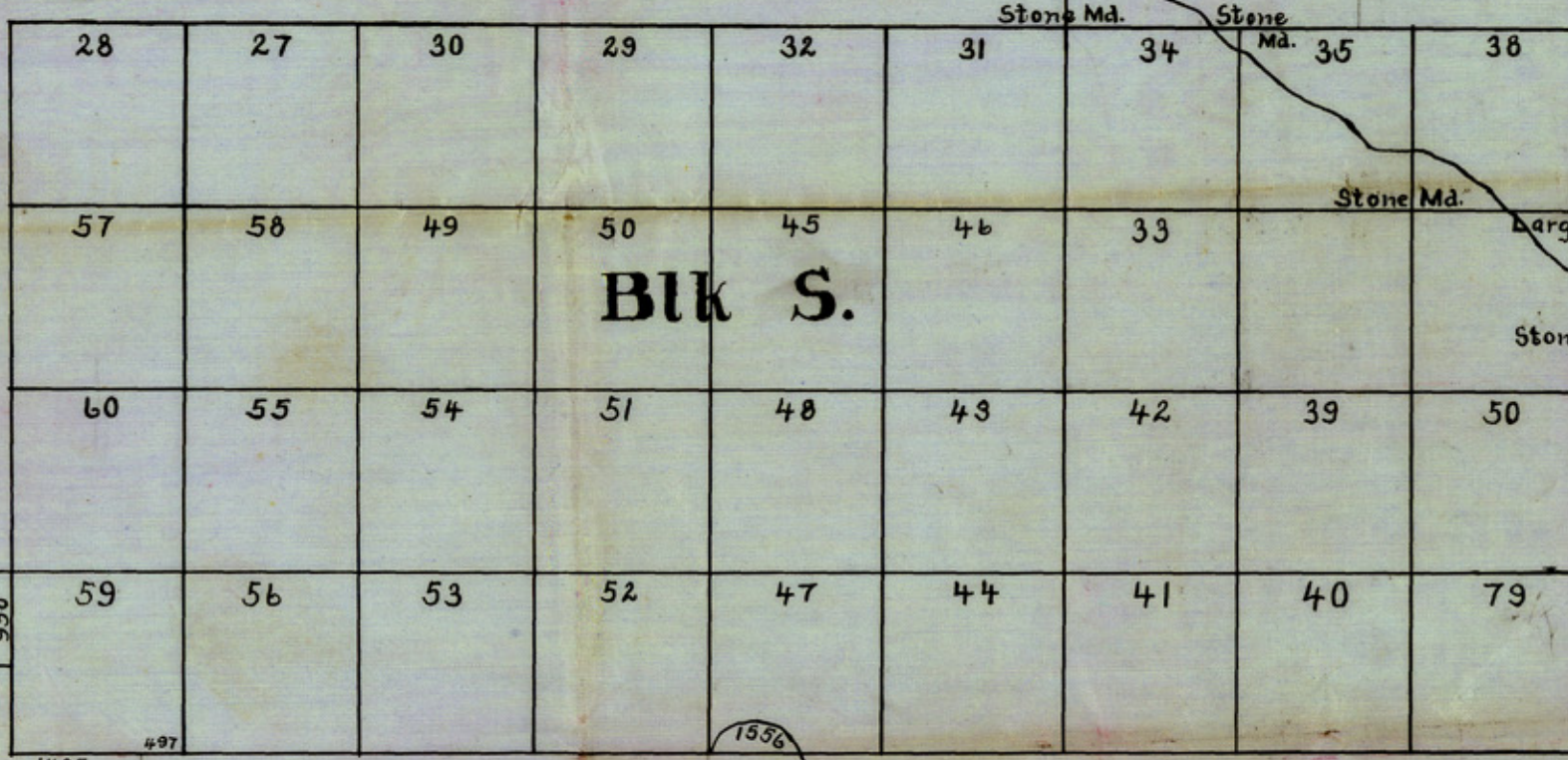


Survey No. 1 Blk. B9.

Begin at a Stake the N.W. cor. of this Survey which Stake is 35 Miles West and 14 miles 950 varas South from the S.E. cor. of N137 Blk 28 of H. & N. R.R. Co. Surveys and 5 miles 1724 varas N. and 1 mile 281 varas North from a Stone Mound on Top of Peak East of the mouth of Plum Creek from which mound a flat top point of Brakes br. N 14° E and West front of Bluff on South West side of Canyon opposite mouth of said Creek br. N 76 1/4° W and a Small of Earth on North side of Canyon is valley at the foot of Brakes br. N 19 1/4° E. Thence S 1900 varas stake mound Thence E 1900 to a Stake & mound for S.E. cor. of this Survey. Thence N at 1750 North fork in all 1900 varas for N.E. cor. of this Survey. Thence W at 700 said North fork in all 1900 varas to Beginning.

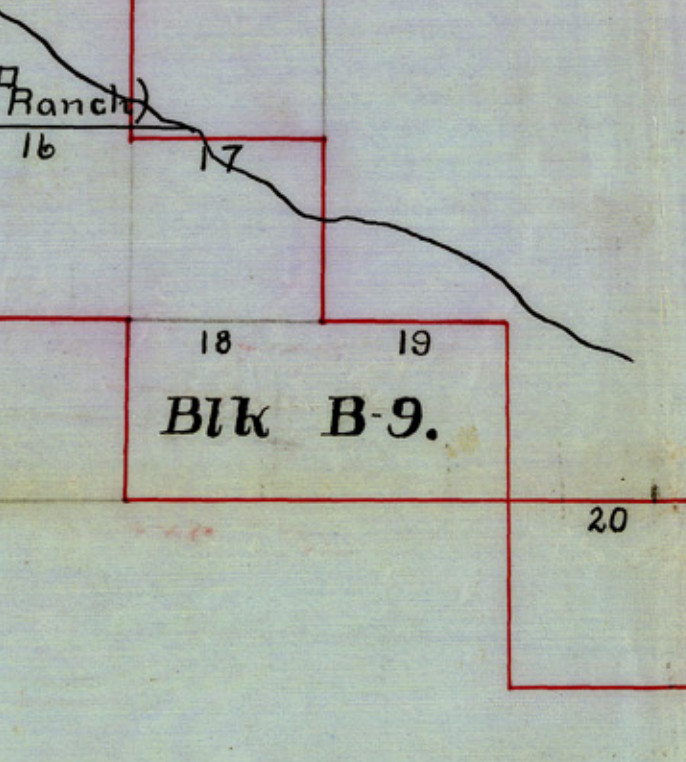
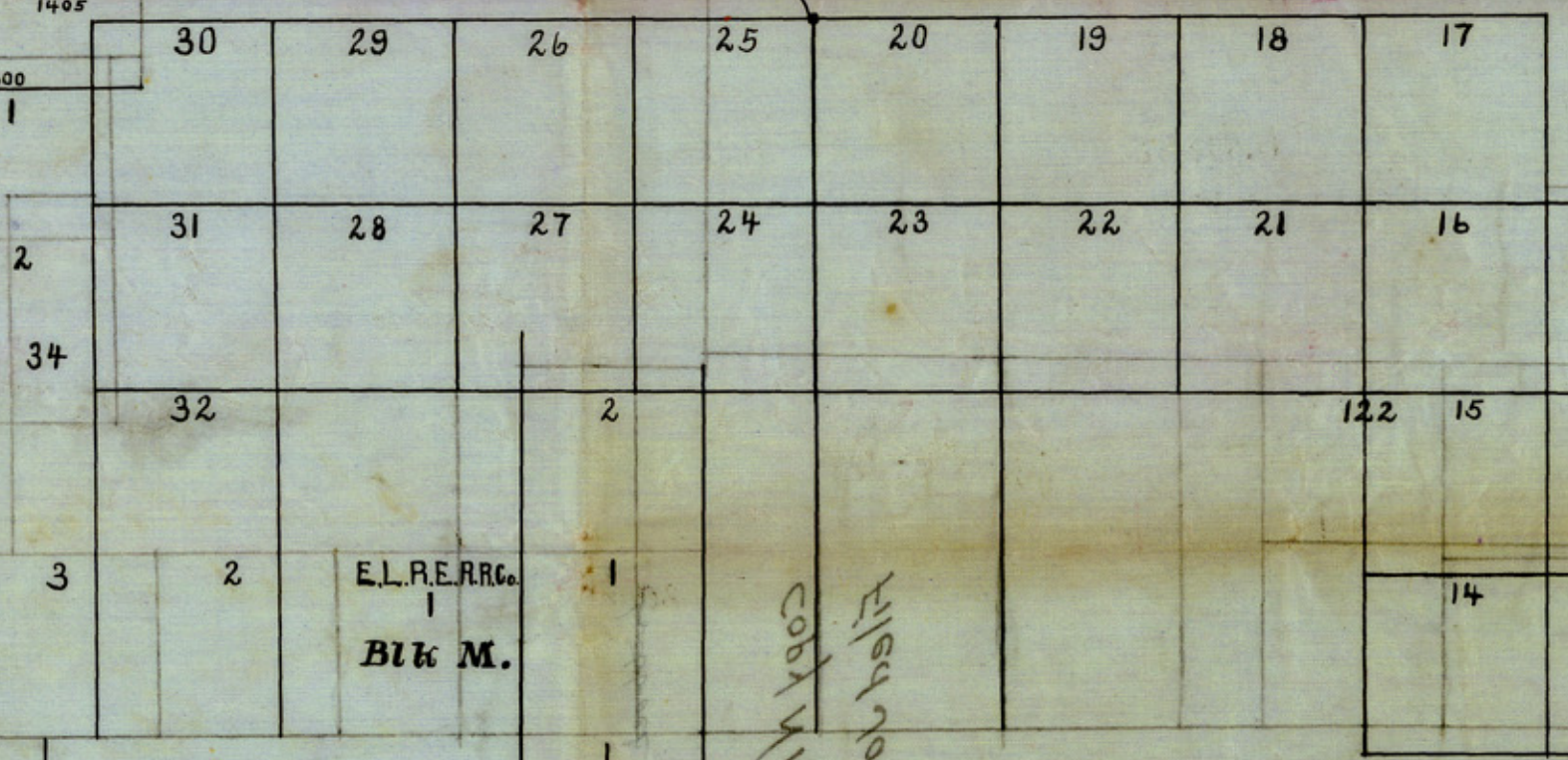
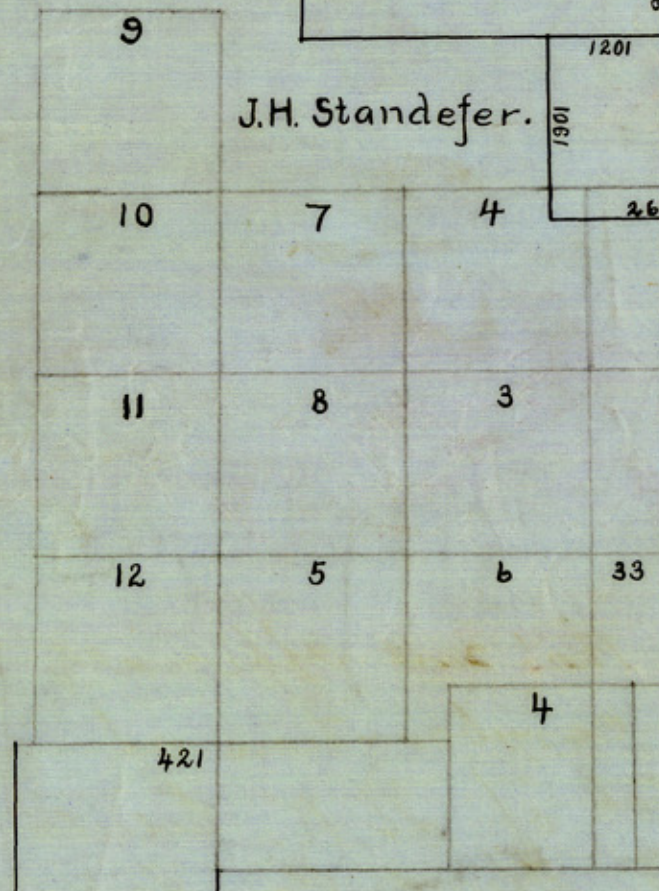
Field notes of Survey No. 4 Blk. B9.

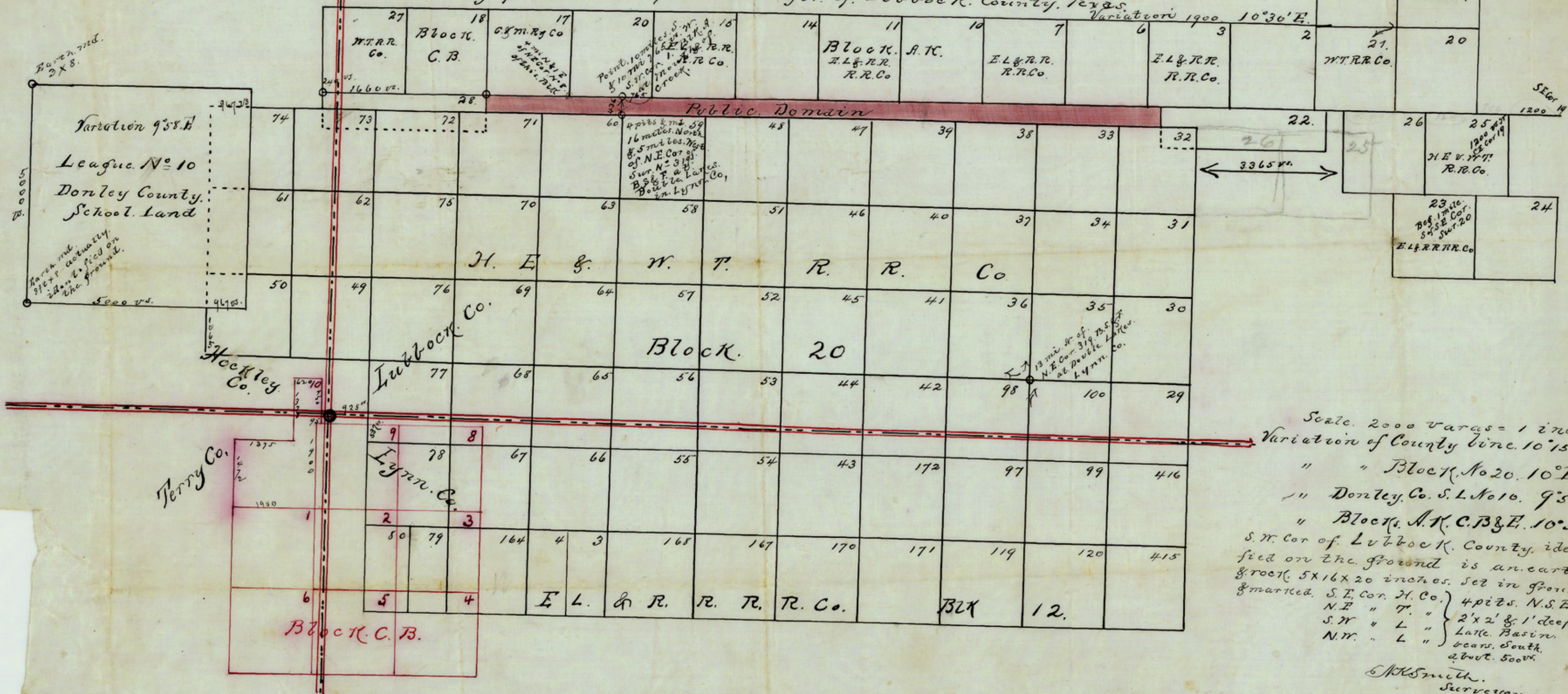
