Dear Sir:-



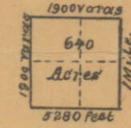
