



I, A. M. H. Stark, County Surveyor of Orange Co. Tex, do hereby certify this map is a true and correct sketch of the land as found by me by actual measurement on the ground. I began at the East end of the Lizzie Higginbotham, where I found the large Sweet Gum as described in the field notes and ran a call to the N.W. Cor. of Higginbotham and came out at the West side of marsh at the mouth of Anderson's Gulch as per field notes. I then ran on around the Higginbotham to the place of beginning. I then ran from the S.W. Cor. of Higginbotham to the N.W. Cor. of Mary A. E. Hall and found Williamson's ditch and long fence as described in field notes. I ran the West line of Hall to the S.W. Cor. and went and found the forked Willow as described in field notes at the upper cor. of Adolph Block on the Neches River. From this corner I ran the A. Block N.W. line and found measurements as shown in sketch.
