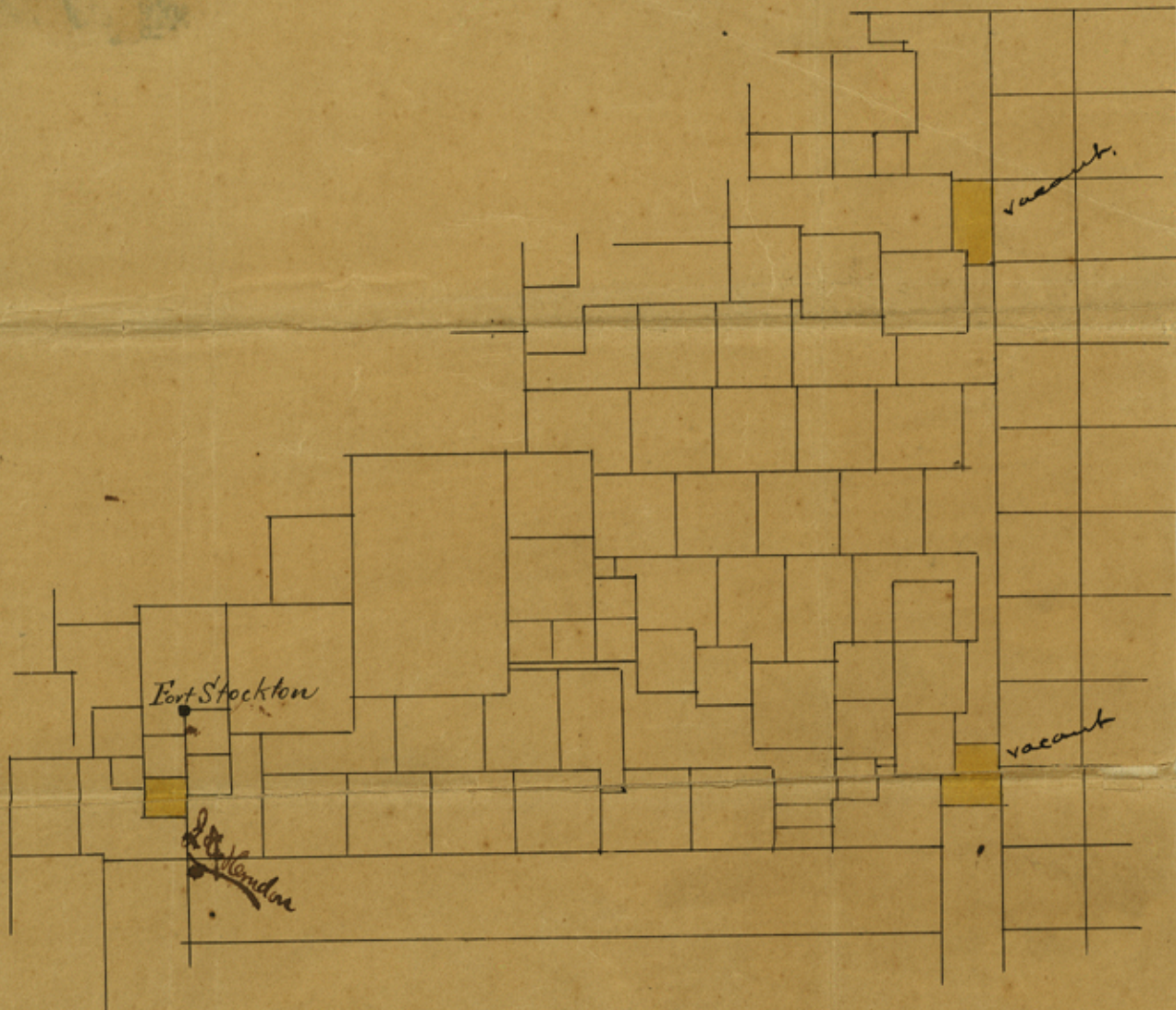

Connecting line run up Pecos County around  
Fort Stockton, Texas.

Beginning at the S. Corner of Survey No 150  
at Stockton J A D Montes a large hole  
4 x 4 x 1 1/2 ft. and rock marked J A D on one  
side and ~~x~~ on the other from which the most  
southerly of twin springs bears N 34° W 24 1/2 vas.  
Cupola of new Court House bears N 31 1/4 W and  
the most northerly point of mesa and of hills to  
West of Stockton bears N 44° 55' W. Thence  
West at 90 vas cross Comanche Creek 950 vas stake  
from which a Rock mkd x set in ground bears  
N 15 3/4 W 10 vas. Thence North at 90 vas cross El  
Paso road at 180 vas cross Fort road at 466 vas  
cross road at 460 vas cross road 450 vas set a stake  
from which a small rock mkd x bears N 23 3/4 W  
9 1/2 vas. Cupola of new Court House bears S 65° E. Thence  
East at 193 vas 605 vas 660 vas 709 vas and 916 vas cross  
roads 950 vas point from which mound of mortar  
bears S 70 1/2 W 34 vas and from mound place where  
head of Long's Spring formerly was bears S 80° W  
30 vas N Corner Corbett's store bears S 79 1/8 W 38 vas  
and head of present spring bears S 64 1/2 W 24 1/2 vas.  
Thence North at 14 vas cross a road at 178 vas  
cross a road at 250 vas cross Overland Stage  
road 500 vas to a point in west side of parade  
ground at Stockton from which the flagstaff  
bears N 25 3/8 E 213 1/2 vas. Thence East 860 vas  
point on bank of Comanche Cr. Flagstaff bears N  
75 1/8 W. Thence North 2411 1/4 vas. Thence East  
1020 vas point. Thence North 1000 vas point  
Thence East 240 9/10 vas point. Thence North at  
56 vas cross a ditch 835 vas cross a ditch 840  
vas to point. Thence West <sup>crossing ditch</sup> 200 vas. Thence North  
105 1/2 vas to the N. W. corner of Survey No 258 in.

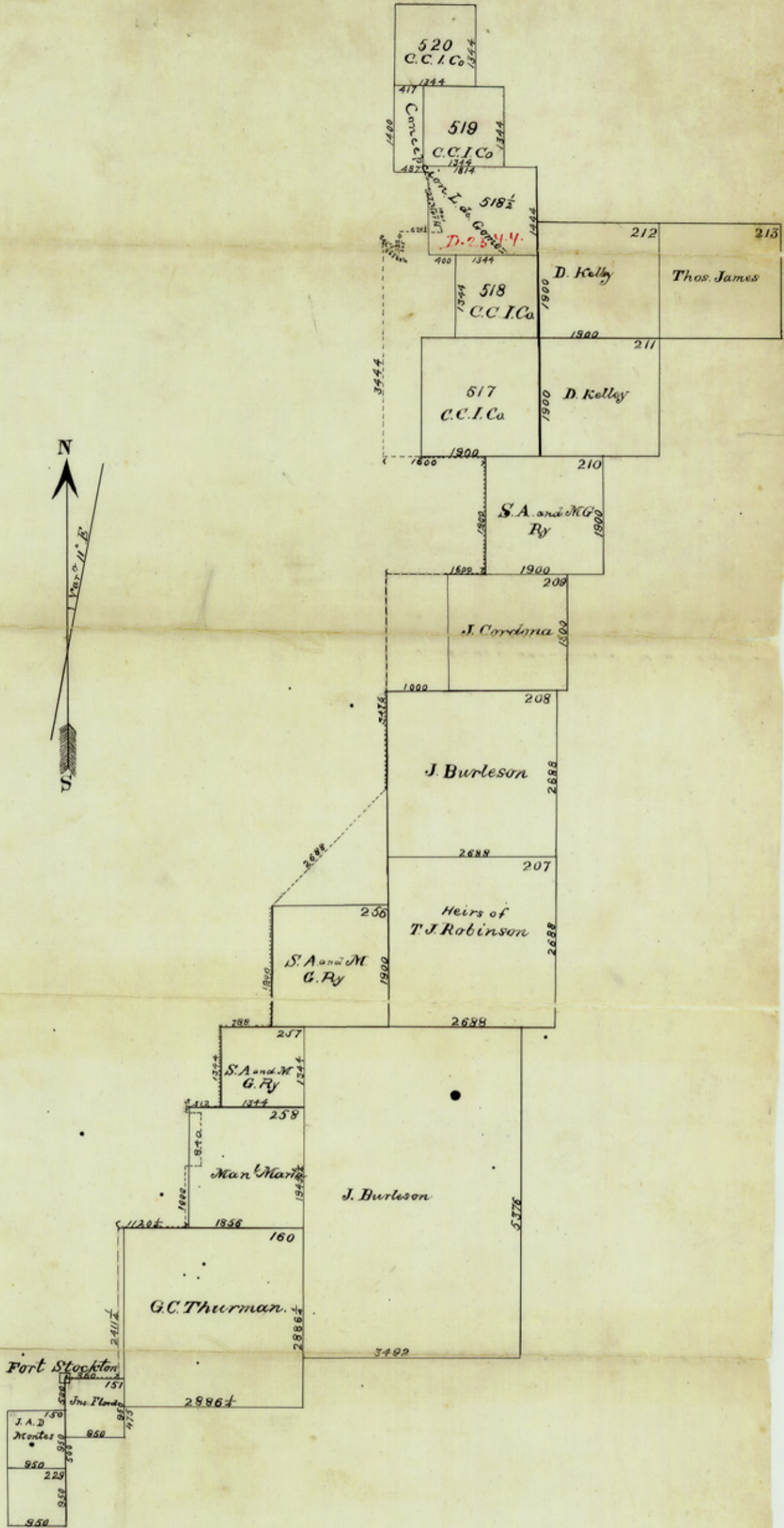
