The size of this strip has never before been surveyed, but certain locations known as Tex. Gen Ry Block R5 have been made to cover this supposed space. I find the the field notes can not be made to fit the older surveys at all. Now Mr Purinton wishes to lease or purchase the land covering the tank shown on sketch; and as you can no doubt find out from the L. O. more readily than I can the standing of these Block R5 locations, I submit the foregoing statement; and request that you advise Mr Purinton what survey will hold in case of a readjustment to conform to the actual lines of older surveys.

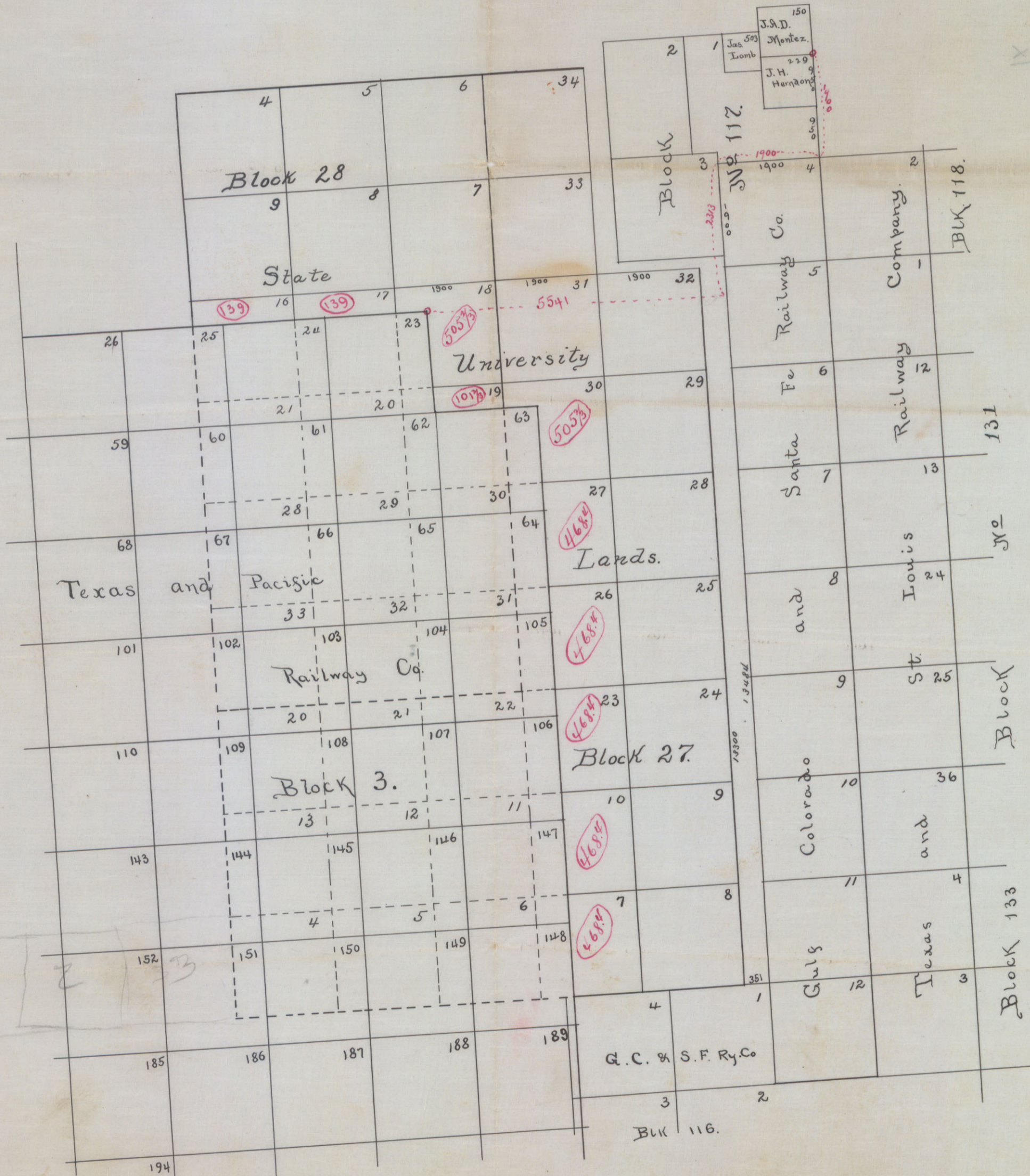

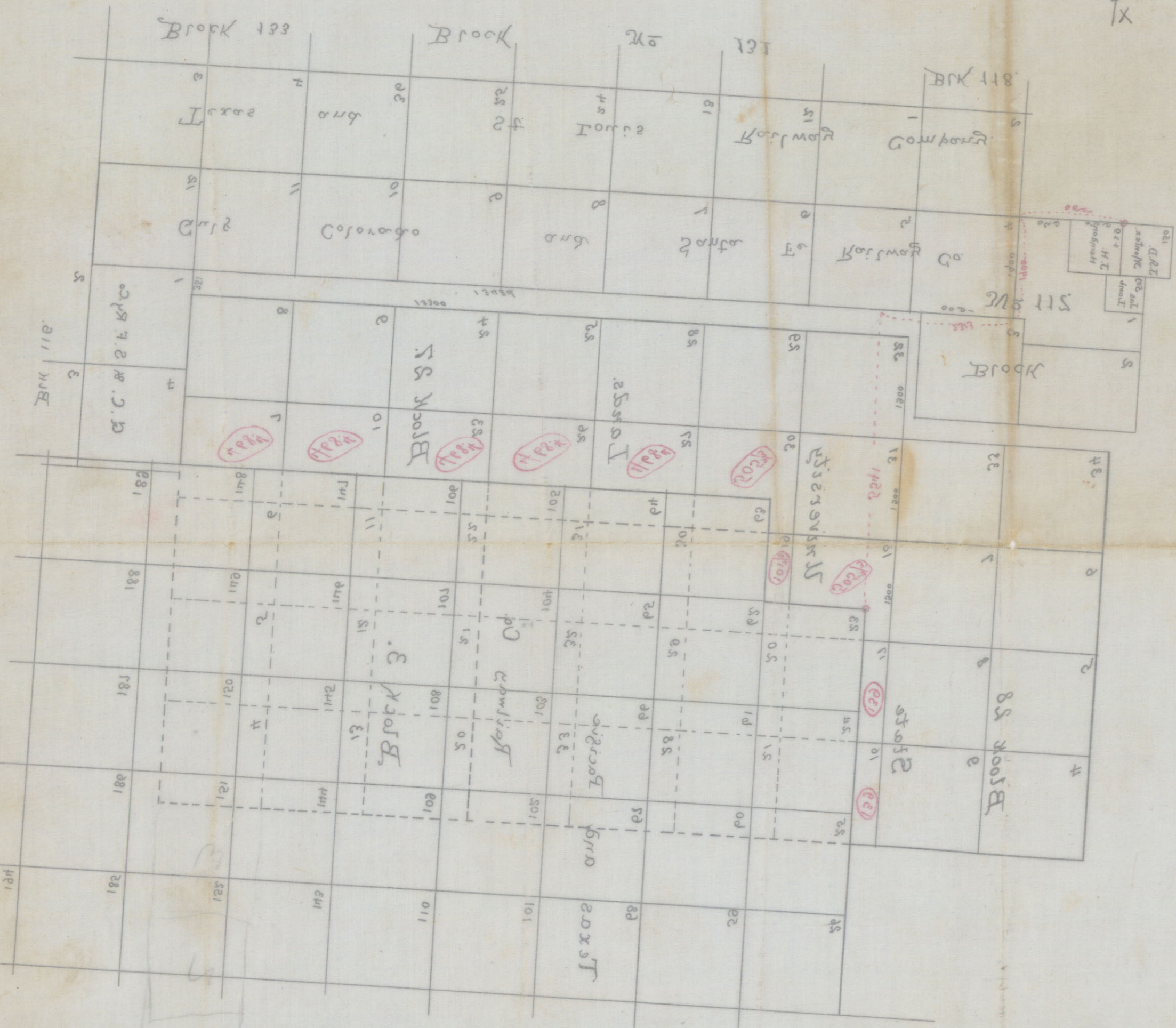
