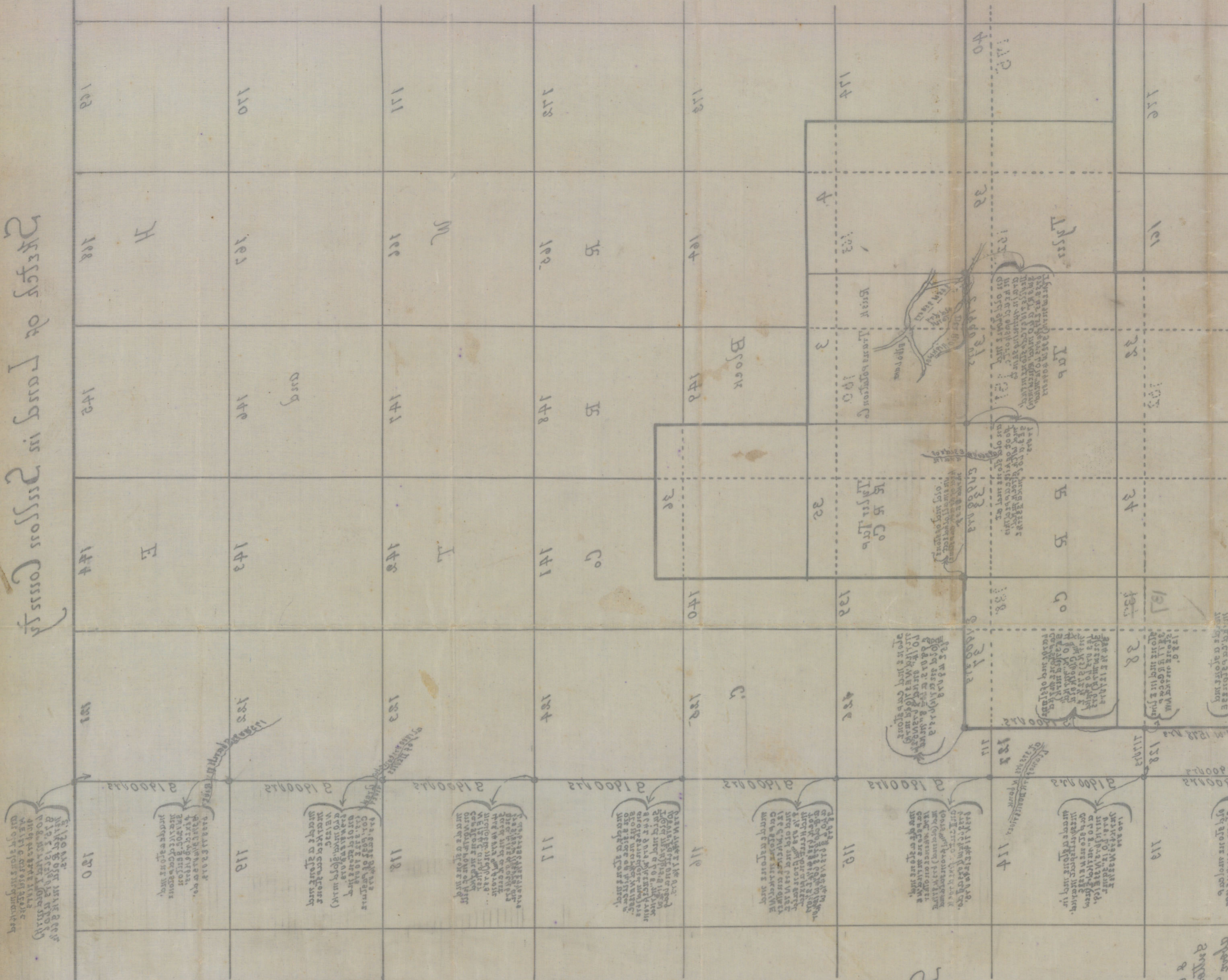

Field notes of a connecting line run from the SW Corner of ~~Survey~~ of Survey No 3, Rusk Transportation Co East and South to the SW Cor of Survey No 38, Tyler Tap RR Co of which the following are field notes.

BEGINNING at an old stone md in head of short drain about 100 vrs long running SE into Devil's River at a point just East of the crossing of the Sonora and Del Rio Highway, said md having been established by E Von Rosenberg in 1898 for the SW Cor Survey No 3, and the SE corner survey No 4, in name of the Rusk Transportation Co and NW Cor Sur 31, NE Sur 39, Tyler Tap RR Co by a connection run S 45 W from Elbow or Kentchler lake, 950 vrs Dec 26th, 1898, and filed in Case No 2307 U S Court, Austin, Texas, I capped this old md with a stone marked SW 3. R. T. at the SW corner of Sur No 3, SE 4, Rusk Transportation Co, whence a LO 10" marked R (new mark) brs S 45 E 37 1/4 vrs, a LO 14" marked T (new mark) brs S 32 W 40 1/2 vrs;

THENCE East with South line Sur 3, Rusk Tr Co, at 40 vrs cross Devil's River at 504 vrs North side of Sonora and Del Rio Highway at 776 vrs S side of S and D Highway at 1600 vrs foot of hill in all 1903 vrs to an old stone md on East foot of high hill the original SE Cor said Sur No 3, Rusk Transportation Co, evidently original corner made by Jacob Kentchler Nov 10th, 1877, for E Von Rosenberg claims to have found at this point an old stone md I capped this md with a flat rock marked SE 3, whence a LO 6" mkd S (new mark) brs S 27 1/2 E 77 vrs;

THENCE East with South line Sur 35, at 360 vrs W bank of a drain in all 1900 vrs to a stone md in small glade at head of drain course East cap stone marked SE 35 at the SE Cor Sur 35 NE 33 and NW corner 37, TT RR Co.

THENCE continuing East with North line Sur 37, this Blk at 360 vrs a drain at 735 vrs bed of Llano prong Devil's River in all crossing the Sonora and Del Rio Highway at 1900 vrs to a stone md on South slope of hill cap stone marked NE 37 (old mrk) at the NE Corner sur 37, TT RR Co, whence a LO 14" marked X (old mrk) brs N 52 1/4 E 98 vrs, a LO 8" same mark (old mrk) brs S 65 E 48 vrs.

THENCE South with East line Sur 37 crossing Llano draw of Devil's River 1900 vrs to a large stone md cap stone marked SE 37 (old mark) at the SE Cor Sur 37, NE 38, TT RR Co, whence a LO 16" mkd X and C (both old mrks) brs S 72 1/2 E 143 vrs a LO 8" marked S (new mark) brs S 84 1/2 E 127 vrs.

THENCE South with East line Survey 38, TTRR Co, over a flat topped hill at 1900 vrs made a stone md capped this md with a stone marked SE 38 at the SE corner of Survey 38, Tyler Tap RR Co, whence a LO 5" mrkd S (new mark) brs N 26 W 36 1/2 vrs a S cut on a fixed rock brs S 41 E 17-1/3 vrs;

THENCE West with South line of said Survey 38 at 1182 vrs pass a stone md cap stone marked NW 128 C in all 1900 vrs to the SE corner of Survey 34, TT RR Co.
