East side of Parade ground at ^{or near} Myers
Spring

Thence N-87 $\frac{1}{2}$ -E 140 varas to
East side of camp ground.

Thence N-38 $\frac{1}{2}$ -E 740 varas to
Myers Spring from whence the S. 24
Corner of Survey No. 335 bears S-45-24
1344 varas.
