I G. W. Lane, County Surveyor of Tom Green County  
 Texas hereby certify, that the foregoing plat represents  
 the true location of the survey thereon as found  
 by me on the ground, and that in making  
 survey for the purpose of ascertaining the location  
 of the S. E. R. R. Survey, we began at the N. W.  
 corner of No. 1 which was found as described  
 on plat. Thence ran N 74° E with the S. E.  
 Reservation line and found everything as  
 shown on plat for a distance of 13300. was  
 Thence South 4992 varas. Thence E 331 varas  
 found a stone mound. Continuing East  
 as shown in red line finding stone mounds  
 as shown also the sections No. 9. at 11731 varas  
 continued East 20929 varas in all  
 Thence South 4887 varas to the S. W. cor of No. 1  
 R. R. survey No. 9 which was found well  
 defined as shown on plat.  
 Thence South 6006 varas to a stone mound  
 from which the S. E. corner of survey  
 No. 639 bears N 78° 54' varas.  
 Thence we continued run connecting lines  
 until we ran all marked red and found  
 all corner and distances which are  
 described in this plat.
