Fieldnotes of connecting lines between the John Barton survey  
No. 80 and Herman Benson survey No. 139.

Beginning at a stake from which a large Live oak, 2 pronged  
with old marks br. N42°W 23 vas, other bearing at N88°E 13.4 gon;  
the NE corner of said John Barton Survey.

Thence N60 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W 708.4 vas. to an old rock md, the NW corner of the  
H. J. Dorroh tract and NE corner of the S. L. Langston tract out  
of said John Barton survey. (The fieldnotes of the H. J. Dorroh  
tract call the distance between these 2 corners = 700 vas.  
(on this course N60 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W at about 350 I strike fence and follow  
same to corner at 708.4.

Thence N60 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W following fence at 809 vas (807 according to  
the Langston fieldnotes) old rock md. from wh: fence runs S30°W.  
From here I ran N60 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W 394 vas, at the distance given in the  
W. M. Glass tract; At 369 vas on this course cross fence and enter  
field. The point 394 falls in ploughed field; so did not find any  
trace of NW corner of said Barton.

Went back to NE corner Barton.

Thence N60 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W at 243.6 vas. stake in North line of the Hermann  
Benson survey.

Thence East following a warbling fence at 777.4 vas. to an  
old rock md on side of bluff, the NE corner of the H. J. Dorroh tract  
of 61 ac. out of said Benson, which mound according to <sup>old</sup> fieldnotes  
of said tract is 1030 vas. East of NW corner said Benson  
and 870 vas. West of NE corner of same.

The intersecting point of the North lines of the two surveys (Barton  
and Benson) therefore is 1647.4 vas. West of NE corner of said  
Benson or 252.6 vas. East of its NW corner.

(In the <sup>John</sup> Bollinger fieldnotes as contained in deed from Chas. Wolf  
the W. H. Chisholm of Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> 1900, the distance from NE corner  
Benson to intersection West with North line Barton is given  
at as 1652 vas. a difference of 4.7 vas. with my running.
