
Enclosed find sketch of the Y. Bergara lands in this county as surveyed by me in January of this year.

The corrected fieldnotes were sent to your office last month, and this sketch shows the surveys, as they actually exist on the ground; In our first survey of this area we attempted to divide the excess among all the sections; However, we had to change this in order to satisfy the actual conditions on the ground.

Surveys 941, and 942 are the oldest surveys, in that area, we have checked their corners, and boundaries, and find that they are situated in their original position, this caused the intervening surveys, 1672, 1673, and 1682 to be a little short in distance North and South, and the North corners somewhat East of their Southern corners, therefore we have taken the only means possible to close these surveys. Survey 1660 has been divided into East and West halves equally, survey 1668 we found short. The East boundaries of surveys 1657, and 374 have their established East line fenced on the originally East line of these surveys and is the old established line that we have known for the West boundary of 1658, 1659, and 1660. We have placed 2" pipes at all corners noted on this sketch. The owners, wish to pay off all the school lands, and are ready to pay off the excess in all the patented land.
