} Field notes of connections run to ascertain
 } the true location of the John Crowover

J. G. Hurd and Danil Lloyd's leagues in Matagorda and Wharton Counties, Texas, and for the purpose of connecting said surveys with the East Texas block of surveys in Wharton Co.

Began at the N.E. cor. of the John Crier league and S.E. corner of the John Crowover league on the west bank of the Colorado river.

Thence S. 62° W. at 2900 vrs Blue Creek (the true crossing of the creek in consequence of a dam founded at its mouth, could not be obtained, because of the high stage of water,) live crosses and recrosses creek a number of times, at 3750 vrs. S.W. cor. of Crowover league, a stake on S. bank of Blue Creek; at 4341 vrs. cross to west side of creek, (found old marks in timber), at 4470 vrs. prairie, at 5291 vrs, a cypress post set for N.W. cor. of John Crier league (now the recognized corner,) at 5313 vrs. a stake set by J. A. Donaldson, appointed by the court in *W. C. Braman, vs. Williams et al* in suit No. 1940, in District Court, Matagorda Co. Texas.

Thence N. 78° W. at 901 vrs a large live oak tree with old marks, at 2888 vrs. a stake set by said Donaldson for N.W. cor. of the J. G. Hurd's league.

Thence N. 62° E. with line between the Hurd and Lloyd surveys, at 1100 vrs. timber, at 1363 vrs Blue Creek, at 1563 vrs. intersect west line of the John

Crownover league. (Mr. Donaldson evidently did not run the west line of the crownover from its S.W. corner and connected with a fence corner which is actually east of the West line of said league some distance, as he makes the distance from N.W. cor of Hurd survey to west line of Crownover league 1646 vrs when in fact it is but 1563 vrs, a difference of 83 vrs.) Continuing N. 62° E. from N.W. cor of Hurd at 2886 vrs. a stake in live oak brush. Bearing called for could not be found.

Thence N. 78° W. 7500 vrs. to a stake, the original N. E. cor. of David Lloyd survey. Could not find the bearing trees called for, but this point is on the west bank of a dry branch with timber.

Thence S. 62° W. at 1563 vrs. west line of Crownover league (no timber near) N.W. cor. of Crownover league bears N. 78° W. 749 vrs.; at 3235 vrs. Blue Creek at 3333 vrs. a stake on west side of Blue Creek. Bearings could not be found.

Thence S. 78° E. passing through a point of Blue Creek timber; some old marks - doubtful - at 2500 vrs a stake in prairie.

Thence N. 62° E. at 524 vrs. intersect stake set by Surveyor Donaldson for N.W. cor. of Hurd survey. While none of the original bearing trees except the large live oak were found, the calls for creek and timber are so close that there can be no doubt surveyor Donaldson is correct in his

location of the Hurd and Lloyd surveys.

Began at the N.W. cor. of Sur. 5, G. C. & S. F. R.R. Co. on E. line Sur. 107, E. T. R. R. Co., 793 vrs S. of its N. E. corner.

Thence East, at 1215 vrs. pass a stake, the N.W. cor. of Sur. 6, G. C. & S. F. R.R. Co., at 2800 vrs. a stake in true west line of the Daniel Lloyd survey 24 1/2 vrs. S. 78° 20' E. of its N.W. cor.

Thence began at S.W. cor. of 5, G. C. & S. F. R.R. Co. a stake in E. line of Sur. 105, E. T. R. R. Co. 1393 vrs. N. of its S.E. corner.

Thence East, 5005 vrs. to a stake in West line of the J. G. Hurd survey, 1188 vrs. S 34° 34' E. of its N.W. corner, as located by surveyor Donaldson. Connections run May 22 to 25, 1899.
