Sir Annexed I send you a sketch of some lands lying in the North east Corner of Houston County. It was drawn by an acquaintance of mine and for the most part from actual observation so that it may be presumed to be tolerably correct. The names of the original granters except two or three are known and are marked on this league. The blank-leagues you will please fill up with the name of the owner and send me the field notes. I am told that these lands, with the exception of a few small tracts sold out of them have not been taxed for the last ten years and I should think it desirable that they should be spread upon the lists of Taxable property if for no other reason than to induce the present claimants, to come forward and substantiate their titles. This at the same time would afford those who have had small surveys made on these lands under the impression that they were vacant an opportunity of raising their certificates to locate them elsewhere.

The field notes of these surveys describe them as situated 30 many miles west from the Saline on the Neches River. On the abstract of Titles I do not find any to suit the Blank Leagues and think it probable they may be found among the Ten League grants, at the end of the Book as several of those surveys are represented to have been made in the neighborhood of J. W. Burton's League. I have been informed that this section of Country would find purchasers if there were not two or three sets of claimants, and it is to quiet these Contentions that I wish to make a true exhibit of the Original Surveys and know whether there is any land yet subject to location.
