This is to advise that I have very carefully examined the Anderson County GLO map for the purpose of locating a survey which has been assigned abstract number 1161. I checked off every survey that was shown on the map with an abstract number, while looking for a survey with the abstract number 1161, and did not find it.

I made a list of every survey on the map that did not have an abstract number shown and then retrieved each of those files from the Archives Division. I have been unable to locate a file which has been assigned abstract number 1161.

Supplement F:

There was a series of Scrap Files approved and assigned abstract numbers and recorded in Supplement F. SF 15848, SF 15849, SF 15853, and SF 15852 were assigned abstract numbers 1157 through 1160, respectively, and 1160 is the last abstract number recorded in Supplement F.

I examined the files for other Scrap Files in the same series, both lower and higher numbers, but none of them were for surveys located in Anderson County.

Supplement G:

Supplement G contains no newly assigned abstract numbers. It contains only changes made to four previously assigned file numbers.

Supplement H:

The same is true for Supplement H. There were no new abstract numbers assigned in this supplement. It contains four changes to previously assigned file numbers.
