

Survey of part of the grant made to one Pedro Sara de Poyas being that part purchased by Vicente Micheli of Estevan Lopez. 21<sup>st</sup> December 1845 the same having been donated to Lopez by his Father in Law the 5<sup>th</sup> of Dec<sup>r</sup> 12 1805 -

On the 14<sup>th</sup> June 1847 I commenced the survey at what is known as the Don Joaquin Crossing of the Angelina River, where are the following witnesses (trees) one Oak 40 in N 18 W 6000 and Oak 20 in S 40 W 11000. Thence with the Trace or Road called the Kings Highway as follows (course)
