

Translation.

To the Governor, William Barr and Davenport, Indian Traders and residents, of this Town, in the best form of law proceeds and says: That Estevan Goguete a resident of this Town in payment of Eight hundred dollars which he is indebted to us, among other things, has transferred to us the possession of a Rancho, comprehending one league of Grazing land for the larger stock at the distance of six leagues to the South from this Town, on the Angelina River, and is bounded on the West by the lands of Tomas Mansola, and on the East with that of Vicente Micheli, on the North to the said River, and on the South with vacant lands, and having transferred said possession to us by his word of honor, because it is only thus he holds it from his Father in law Pedro de Lara, owner of said Rancho as will appear from the document herewith enclosed to Your Goodship, that you may interpose your Authority and supply all the defects of this transfer; you will be pleased to order that we be put in possession of the aforesaid Rancho and that it be truly ours. —

Therefore we pray you be pleased to order that possession be given us as aforesaid in which we will receive justice, declaring that we do not proceed through malice &c. and further pray you to admit this petition on this present common paper, for the want of the Stamped.

Town of Newy doches May 1st 1810. = Barr and Davenport, — Being presented and admitted on this common paper, with the document referred to, let there be transmitted

to His President of this Town Don Pedro Procela, that
he may cite the parties adjoining and with two
existing witnesses, repair to the place indicated
by the party, make an examination, verify the
Survey and inform me of the condition and quality
of the lands, its waters and the corresponding
value of it, ~~to~~ through appraisers agreeable to
the Tarif for grazing lands and the date thereof
with any thing else that may occur to you. —
Sancedo. — Don Manuel de Salcedo Lieuten-
nant Colonel of Infantry of the Royal Army,
Political and Military Governor for His Ma-
jesty of the Province of Texas and New Filipin-
nas, on the 25th day of May 1810. Decrees it
before me to which I Certify. — Manuel Del-
gado Notary. — On the same day, month
and year, ~~the~~ the undersigned Notary notified
and caused ~~it~~ ^{the foregoing decree} to be made known to Don William
Barr, and the Commissioner Don Pedro Pro-
cela in their proper persons, and as evidence
of their being duly notified they sign it with
me to which I Certify, Delgado. — Barr and
Davenport. — Pedro Procela. — In the Town
of Navojoles, on the 28th May 1810, By
virtue of the Decree of the Governor Lieutenant
Colonel Don Manuel de Salcedo, I repaired
with two existing witnesses, who were ap-
pointed at the same time appraisers of the
Rancho mentioned by the party, which will
be found at the distance of five leagues
from this Town towards the South on the other
side of the Angelina River, and summing
the parties adjoining an examination was
made, the Cordel of measurement was —

Extended, and the land which embraces
the Rancho was found to form a triangle
or angle of two sides. Which from South to West
has the distance of three leagues and from
North to South, about one league, and from
West to East one league, and in computing
said triangle it will contain a little more
than a league, on said Rancho there is
good land for farming, which might
quire three bushells of seed corn; it has
the water from a Spring branch and also from
the River Angelina, but neither of these
will serve for irrigation, it has good pas-
tures the year round; it has no drawbacks
other than the insects that impede the rais-
ing of stock; and for all as aforesaid, the
two witnesses and appraisers having agreed
with me that the utmost they could val
said land was Thirteen dollars, and that
may be known to the Governor, to whom it
should be returned according to the provisions
of said Decree; the aforesaid witnesses and
appraisers sign it with me in the aforesaid
Town, on the same day, month and
Year = Pochu Procela. = Witness Joaquin
Montes de Oca. = Ap. Witness Jose de los Santos
Procela. = J. Don Jose Antonio Sausedo 1st
member of the Most Excellent Provincial
Deputation of Texas, and Provisional Political
Chief of the Same; do Certify in due form that
the foregoing testimonio, is literally taken
from the original on file in the Archives of
the Department of this Province, corrected
and compared in presence of the witnesses

residents of this City Don Francisco Bustillo,
Pablo Salinas and Manuel Gortari, at the re-
quest of Don Ramon Musquis at the charge of the
party interested; and in Testimony Whereof and
that it may have the validity required by law,
I attest and sign it with two assisting Wit-
nesses in default of a Notary, In this Town
of San Fernando de Bexar on the 20th March

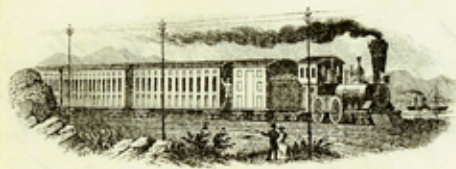

judicial y supliendo todos los defectos de este testamento se sirva mandar
que se nos ponga en posesion del ya expresado Rancho y que nos quede y
subsista Portanto - A V. S. pedimos se sirva mandar. y por ser como ya antes
expuesta en lo que recibiremos mas justicia juramos no ser de malicia y en lo nec
sario se y nos admita esta peticion en el presente pueblo comun por medio
del sellado Pueblo de Nacogdoches y Mayo 1º de 1860 años Paul y Davenport
