The lands asked for in the petition of
Vicente Micheli —

At the time when I resided in this Town
of Nacogdoches I acquired by way of legal pur-
chase from the Indian Known as the Son of
the Sordo (deaf) of the Bidais Nation of Indians
a piece of land, which will be found sit-
uated on the Neches River from the Bidais
Creek, to the place where the aforesaid deaf
Indian lived on the left margin of the
aforesaid Neches River, to the South of ~~the~~
Town of Nacogdoches distant about 7. or 8.
leagues ~~of~~ —

The Land designated by title to the
aforesaid Vicente Micheli. We repaired to the
Rancho of the aforesaid Vicente Micheli, whose
land will be found on the left bank of the River
Neches about 8. leagues distant from the
aforesaid Town on a course to the South, and ha-
ving taken especial charge of said land
and leagues mentioned by the party at the
same time measuring the land according
to the orders in the preceding decree
a league and a half was measured to him from
North to South, containing 7500. vs. lying from
the boundary of the resident Estevan Goqueta
as far as the bank of the Neches River, And
from West to East, from the Creek of the deaf
Indian to the Bidais Creek, there was mea-
sured and given to him 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ leagues contain-
ing 27500. vs. in virtue whereof &c —

A new order issued in regard to the above
in consequence of the omission on the part of —
Micheli to state the value of the Goods given
for Said land &c.

To effect that which I am ordered in
the foregoing Decree of the Governor Don Manuel
Salcedo I repaired with two assisting witnesses —

and after citation to the parties adjoining, I measured the Two leagues of Pasture land, which is designated by the Course from the West to the Margin of the Neches River; and by other Courses the corresponding Corners are made at the termination of the aforesaid Leagues, leaving the remainder of the Land vacant &c —

The Land asked for in his petition

" You will please to order me the possession of a piece of land suitable for a Stock Rancho and Labor, which will be found on the other side of the Angelina River where the Loco Creek enters said River, which lies between the East and South, praying that of said place there be given me, to the West 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ leagues, and to the South 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ lea, and to the East to where the lines of Gogote are -

The Land granted in Title

In the Town of Nacogdoches on the 28th April 1810. in obedience to the foregoing decree of the Gov^r Manuel Salcedo. I repaired to the Ranchos of Tomas Mansola which will be found on the other side of the Angelina River about five leagues distant from this Town. toward the South. And with the two witnesses who accompanied me, with notification to the parties adjoining, I made an examination and taking the proper measurement the space of one and a half leagues was found, not having asked a greater extension on the South, by being obstructed by the possession of William Barr and Davenport which is the oldest title, and with which it is bounded; And to the East with the lands that belonged to Steven Gogote, and now belonging to the aforesaid Barr and Davenport, And to the North, with the aforesaid River,


