

The Land asked for in the petition of Lucubidini  
 "That being in want of a piece of land which will  
 be found on the other side of the Angelina at the  
 place called the "Durasno", contiguous to the land  
 belonging to Estevan Gozete, granting to me a league  
 to each Cardinal point at said place, with  
 all &c. - -

The Land granted in the title dated 20 June 1802  
 J. D. Jose Flores Procurador of this Town of Navajo  
 doches by virtue of the orders in the foregoing Decree,  
 repaired to the place called the "Durasno", which  
 is the place asked for the Rancho and Labor,  
 and I have designated to begin on a course to the  
 West bounding with Estevan Gozete one league,  
 to the South one league, to the North another,  
 and to the East, the same: taking them by the hands,

Pedro de Lara (Father in law to E. Gozete),  
 the Land asked for in his petition.

Having presented myself as King for the  
 lands on both sides of the Angelina at the  
 Crossing called Don Joaquin, the procurador J.  
 Cayetano de Lepeda who was the actual procurador  
 at that time was ordered to give me possession  
 of the land that was asked for, without  
 injury to a third party, and the said Procurador  
 not finding any impediment whatever to extend  
 said possession, it was extended to me on the 16<sup>th</sup>  
 May of the year 1792, from said Crossing to the  
 Southwardly to the "Parisagua" Creek where it  
 enters the Angelina River; and on this side of  
 the River Eastwardly to the "Palisada" where  
 the "La Nana" enters the Angelina River, being bound  
 ed by the lands of the Mission to the place where  
 the Moral Creek enters the aforesaid Angelina  
 River, to the North, and on that side of the afore  
 said River Westwardly with the Public Road  
 over

to the "Placeta", and by or through the "Castanos" mainie to the "Lagunitas"; and having looked for the ~~the~~ said Title in the Archives, and not being able to find the same, ~~It~~ it necessary to beg of you to extend the title of possession to me on the same terms as heretofore &c. —

= Here a new order is issued by Capt. Rodriguez to Gregoria Mora to put the party in possession of the land in accordance with the petition aforesaid — And Gregoria Mora by virtue of said order repairs to the land &c. <sup>both sides of</sup> on the Angelina River at the place called the Crossing of Don Joaquin after citation to the parties ~~adjoining~~ and finding no impediment whatever, I gave him on this side. Course to the West to the junction of the Moral Creek with said River, and upwards with said Creek to a Crossing known as the Old Crossing, and is bounded by the lands of the Reverend Fathers on the East, to the La Nana Creek, and joins with the aforesaid River to the North, as far as the Spring of Water known as the "Palisada," which serves as a landmark, being bounded by the lands of Manuel Mora; On the other side of the aforesaid River, Course to the South as far as the "Lagunitas" which serves as a Landmark and is bounded with the Land of Vicente Michile, and <sup>takes</sup> gives a turn by the point of a creek or Valley, Course to the West, as far as the "Cariso" Creek. Which enters the aforesaid River, and is bounded by the lands of Tomas Mansola, and to the East to the Creek called the Parisagua to its junction with the aforesaid River and is bounded with the lands of Jose Lucubichi, &c.

The transfer of Pedro de Lara to Estiven Goyette (his Son in law, before Captain Rodriguez &c. He transfers to his Son in Law Stephen Goyette all the title and possession above mentioned in the —

of the said title, <sup>reserving</sup> ~~with the~~ only ~~exception~~ of said land the "Placeta" which will be found on the Public Road on a course to the West as far as the boundary of the land at present possessed by Tomas Mansolo - &c - done on the date of the title - 20<sup>th</sup> Decr. 1805. - on the 21<sup>st</sup> Decr. 1805 Estevan Loquete transfers at his right and title to Vicente Michili. —

On the 15<sup>th</sup> May 1810. Vicente Michili petitions for causes set forth, prays to be repossessed of said land by a new title and adjudication from the Governor Don Manuel Salcedo, who issues his orders and Commissions Pedro Pirela to survey the same. &c —

In obedience to the orders of the Gov<sup>r</sup> and Lieut Col. Manuel de Salcedo, I repaired with two witnesses to the place designated by the party interested, after citation to the parties adjoining I made an examination under my own supervision and found the Area of four leagues of Pasture land which is embraced by 4000, vs. that there is on this side of the Angelina River, which goes as far to the North as the Palisada Creek, from the West to the East there is  $\frac{3}{4}$  league from the La Nana Creek to that of the Morral, both of which enter the Angelina River on the South side, the half of this portion which is in favor of this party on the Eastern side, and on the other or South side of said River, there is place marked called the Sagunitas - and on the East, the Creek called the Parisagua, and on the West as far as the Placeta, where the old marks remain. &c —
