Thomas Mansolo

Thomas Mansolo applies to the Lieutenant Governor of the Village of Pecos, to be put in possession of a "Rancho" on the Angelina river, at the mouth of Ecco creek (Angelina Co).

On the 10th of April 1810, the Lieutenant Governor of Pecos orders the "Procurador" to put the applicant in possession of said land — (No title of possession appears in the papers.)

On the 23rd of April, 1810, Thomas Mansolo applies to the Governor of Texas, stating that, having so far, failed to obtain a title of possession to his land, he wishes to have it issued to him.

On the 26th of April, ⁽¹⁸¹⁰⁾ the Governor appoints Pedro Procela as a special commissioner, to examine and survey the land, and to report on the same.

On the 28th of April, 1810, Pedro Procela, makes his report of survey and examination of the land.
(No title of possession)

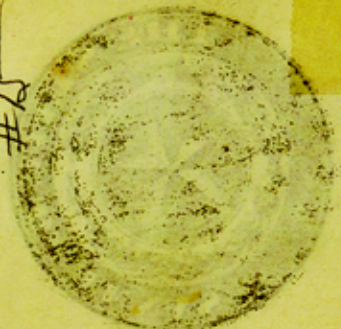
