of Nacozoches Co. in the year 1847

Beginning on the South side of the River Angelina
on the present Co. of Angelina at what was known
at the time of surveying as the Don Joaquin Crossing
An Oak 40 in N 18 W. 6 vs an oak 20 in S 10 W 11 in
dist. Thence with the meanders of S Highway as follows
S 37 W. 120 m. S 40 W 190 m. S 27 W. 220 m S 8 1/2 E 145
S 10 W 825 m S 50 W. 2411. S 85 W. 180 m. S 57 W. 370 m
S 45 W 1411 m. S 61 W 220 m South 50 m S 45 W 140 m
S 76 W. 2780 m. S 40 W 310 m S 52 W. 70 m S 60 W 350 m
S 25 W. 3420 m. West 200 m S 50 W 600 m S 10 W 570 m
S 30 W 550. S 15 W. 660 m S 40 W. 1460 m S 10 W 800 m
S 20 W 960 m S 33 W. 759 m to cor at the "Laganitas"

Thence a South westerly co. with said highway
to the S.W. cor of Mechele's Grant as at present
represented on the Map of Angelina Co.
