To make these Surveys for Dodge & James. I commenced at the NW Corner of B.R.C. Mudd League at an old mound shown to me by Mr. Gilliland who lives near this corner & is a very old settler here. From this corner we chain S45E on an old blazed line 2500 was & find another mound one bearing tree m.kd X dead took new bearings & not being able to find the Miller League line we went to H. Stagners NW corner a Pine m.kd HS & 2 Pines X thence N45W at 2500 was I find the line that I run N45E from Mudds SW corner. Chain back on this line 730 was to his corner. Then from H. Stagners NW corner I chain S45E at 2500 was & find his SW corner. Thence N45E on his South line at 870 was a Road at 1080 was Caney Creek at 1710 was to W.B. Andersons NE corner. Thence with Andersons line S45E (this line has been rerun since the War & m.kd 3 hacks) at 570 branch of Caney at 1320 Crosses Caney Creek at 3800 a corner Post Oaks bearing trees. Then S45W 780 was Beef Road at 3970 a Branch at 4220 was an old line 3 hacked running East & a line runs S15W (supo<sup>This seems to be erroneous as the line East of the line S15W (supo^s) do not cross Andersons line at the same place and would make Andersons S.E. line 7348 ss.)
-sing this to be Bowtons North line I followed & chained it 2000 was when it gave out no line run from this) I returned & followed Andersons line at 5270 was Cross a Road & at 5800 was enter a cane bottom at 6100 Cross a Creek at 6420 was to Big Creek running SW & at 6823 was a corner 2 Maples bearing trees, m.kd WBA. Thence N45W on his end line at 1680 was a Branch at 3800 was corner in old hurricane on 2 small Pines Thence S45W on Robertsons line (m.kd 3 hacks nearly grown out-) at 960 was a corner a 30 Pine N12W 6 was & a 30 Pine S66E at 1000 was on this line I find a 3 foot Pine with 10 hacks or notches & at 1543 the line stops make corner & chain & mark N45W 1500 was no sign of the old line. I then return to J. G. Grahams NE corner a 2 foot Pine m.kd H. S85W 7 was & a 1 foot Pine m.kd H. bns S57W 16 was Thence North on Demahoo's line at 860 was to the West line of Robertson. Then with his line S45E at 690 was to Robertsons SW corner. I then went to the corner of N. Bowton & Conn on J. Browns South line a Stake, a Sweet Gum bns S85W 4 & a 14 Post Oak S81W 13 was & a Red Oak m.kd MBL S49W 15 was, then with this line S75W at 295 was Branch at 700 Greens Creek at 750 same 800 same at 970 to Chalk Creek at 1135 was to Andersons line 220 was from his SW corner & at 1482 was Cross Andersons West line 130 was above his SW corner & at 1850 was old corner a 20 Blk Gum N30E 12 was & 18 Red Oak N73E 15 was, I then return to Conn's corner & chain N75E 650 was to his J. Browns SE corner, then N15W at 1200 Andersons line 1350 Chalk Creek at 1680 corner a Sweet Gum m.kd W S42E 1, & 14 inch Post Oak bns East 4 ft was m.kd X then</sup>
