 3 League of Land in order to more clearly to establish
 4 its identity on the ground & began 2500 m S45W from
 5 the S.W. corner of the Aaron Ashley League of Land
 6 on the S.E. Boundary line of the W.B. Anderson
 7 League of Land & thence from which a blackoak
 8 was grow 15 m dist thence S45W 6190 m to the S.W.
 9 corner of the W.B. Anderson League of Land
 10 the Stephen Stocton calls for the S.W. corner of
 11 another survey at the distance of 6190 m hence the
 12 the call for the S.W. corner of the Anderson
 13 agrees with the call of said Stocton survey in
 14 course and distance thence S45E at 4038 m find
 15 old marks on this course and pine trees to
 16 correspond with the calls of said Stocton but
 17 burned out thence N45E 6190 m mostly through
 18 a Turricane timber mostly blown down reached
 19 a cluster of scruboaks on the S.W. boundary
 20 line of the Aaron Ashley League of Land
 21 here the original fieldnotes of the Stephen
 22 Stocton called for a ^{blackoak} live oak & in dia and
 23 likely the scruboaks were mistaken for
 24 liveoaks thence N45W at 1538 m to the S.W.
 25 corner of said Ashley League of Land
 26 at 4038 m the place of beginning
 27 I found marks on all those lines.
 28 As the Stocton Survey calls to begin at a corner
 29 of the Ross M. Bridges & began at the north
 30 corner of said Stocton survey and
 31 ran west on a plainly marked old blazed
 32 line the distance the Ross Bridges Survey.

Original fieldnotes call for a Blackoak.

1 calls to Run which is 6250 rs and at this point
2 found an oak tree with marks as were usually
3 made on timber at the date of the Bridges Survey
4 Thence South finding a dimly marked line
5 at 4000 rs find such timber as called for at
6 this point but nothing marked Thence
7 East and a portion of this line I find
8 plainly marked and at 6250 rs in the pine
9 woods I come to a cluster of Bay timber as
10 is called for at this point found no marks
11 but found where a large Bay had stood but
12 down now Thence North 4000 rs this line dimly
13 marked
