

The State of Texas — Plat and field notes of  
County of Angelina — A resurvey of the Jacob-  
Shelton league of land titled to Jacob Shel-  
ton Sept. 15<sup>th</sup> 1835, the same being situated in  
the County and state aforesaid about 20 miles



of land titled to J. F. Middleton Sept. 10<sup>th</sup> 1851  
Said league of land lying and being situate in  
the County of Angelina and state of Texas on the  
waters of the Neches River about 32 miles S.E.  
from the town of Lufkin and bounded and  
identified by said resurvey as follows to wit.  
Beginning at S.E. cor. of the Jacob. Shelton league  
a stake the original bearing tree being ~~extinct~~  
~~older than 3 years~~. Thence South at 310 m.s.  
Branch course N.E. At 358 m.s pine on south of  
branch line tree old blazes on 4 sides at 830 m.s  
old blaze on the North side of a 25 inch pine  
at 1300 m.s S.E. line of Sec- 49 of E. T. R.R. Co. at 3600 m.s  
branch crossing same several times and leaving  
it at 3900 m.s Course S.E. at 3458 m.s a pine  
18' dia. old blazes on both sides. At 3500 m.s  
Cor. Thence West at 100 m.s road at 530 m.s  
branch course S.E. at 880 m.s branch course  
South at 1440 m.s Loggins Creek ten m.s wide
