County of Angelina state of Texas, and  
bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point 10<sup>no</sup> East of a  
pine 24" in dia. marked **I.B.** the same  
being also blazed on East side from best  
evidence blaze showed to have been about  
60 years another pine 30" bus S 15 W 15<sup>no</sup>  
having on it a like blaze on N. E. side  
Thence West at 1500<sup>no</sup> logging creek  
75<sup>no</sup> wide course south a hickory on  
West bank of same blazed East and  
West side, blaze very old at 7200<sup>no</sup>  
find an old blazed line running  
North + South; find no original bearing  
trees for cor. establish new cor bearing  
trees marked  $\frac{3}{2}$  a pine 20" bus S 45 E. 5<sup>no</sup>  
Dv. 16" West. Thence North on said  
old line the same being visible and  
plain until we strike storm path  
at 2000<sup>no</sup>. at 3570<sup>no</sup> to the S. B. line of  
the Sam Bates league in said storm  
path found no old bearing trees, blazed  
three small pines as pointers

newly established cor. Thence East  
 on said Bates S. B. line 2200 to pass his  
 S. E. cor. at 7200 to a stake at a point  
 2' to south of a pine 24" in dia said pine  
 being blazed with old blazes on West  
 North and South sides best evidence  
 show said blazes to be about 60 years  
 old. Thence South at 3510 to  
 the beginning:

The East and West boundary lines  
 being run on a variation of  $7^{\circ} 30'$

The North and South boundary lines  
 being run on a variation of  $8^{\circ} 30'$
