Charles H. Beattie being duly sworn according to law deposes and says as follows —
1st That, as the agent of the "Corpus Christi Deep-Water, Harbor and Channel Company" a Corporation organized and acting under the laws of the State of Texas, and, under instructions from said Company, he did, on the thirteenth day of November A. D. 1888, enter upon the waters and lands situated in the County of Neches, hereinafter more particularly described, and did locate and take the same for and on behalf of the said Company as and for a site for the construction of certain Channels, Harbors, Docks, Piers & Breakwaters as is provided by Chapter 100. of the General laws of Texas, as enacted by the 20th Legislature of said State, and that he continues to hold the possession of the same as such Agent, and for and in the name of said Company.

2^d That the lands and waters so taken and held for said Company as aforesaid are described by Metes and Bounds as follows. —

1st line. Beginning at Stake No. 0. which is situated on the Northeastern extremity of Mustang Island and from which the Aransas Pass Light-house bears North 20° west. And the U. S. Life Saving Station bears North 97° 45' west; — thence West by North one half mile to Stake No 1. which

is situated at the South side of the entrance to
Turtle Cove: thence W. by S. $\frac{1}{4}$ mile along the
North coast of Mustang Island to Stake No. 2
thence in same direction $\frac{3}{4}$ mile along same
coast to Stake No. 3, thence in same direction and
along same shore one mile to Stake No. 4, thence
W. by S. $\frac{1}{2}$ S. along same coast one mile to Stake
No. 5: thence in same direction and along same
shore one mile to Stake No. 6, thence S. W. one mile
across open bay to Stake No. 7

2d line Beginning at Stake No. 1. north which is
situated at the N. side of the entrance to Turtle Cove:
and N. by W. from U. S. Life Saving Station thence
W. by S. $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to Stake No. 2. north, thence W. by S.
 $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to Stake No. 3. north, which is at the S. E. ex-
tremity of Harbor Island, thence in same direction
along the S. coast of Harbor Island one mile to Stake
No. 4. north, thence in same direction along the
same shore one mile to Stake No. 5. north which is
at the S. W. extremity of Harbor Island, thence
W. by S. $\frac{1}{2}$ S. across open bay $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to Stake No. 6. N.
thence in same direction $\frac{1}{4}$ mile across open bay
to Stake No. 7. north.

3d line Beginning at Stake No. 1. north described in
notes of line No. 2, thence N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ mile along west
bank of Aransas Harbor to Stake No. 2: thence
N. by E. along same bank $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to Stake No. 3:
thence in same direction, and along same bank

$\frac{3}{4}$ mile to stake No. 40: thence Northerly along
same bank $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to stake No. 50: thence Nor-
therly along same bank one mile to stake No.
60: The lands so taken and held being the
Northerly 300 feet off of Mustang Island;
and the Easterly and Southerly 300 feet
off of Harbor Island. The said strips
extending along the lines already design-
ated herein and shown on the map
or plat hereto attached: and the waters
so taken and held are those of Austin Cove
and so much of the several channels as
lie between Mustang, Harbor and St Joseph
Islands, and are designated and included
between the several lines as shown on said
plat or map.
